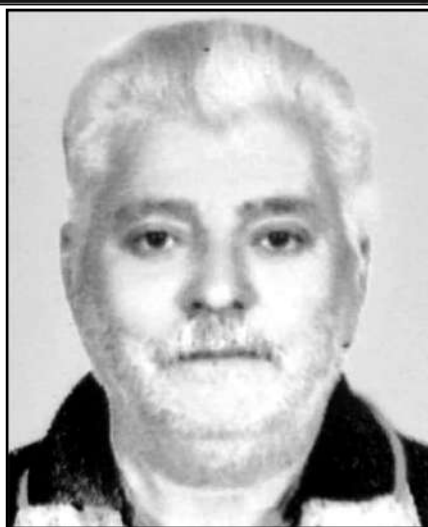
SHRADHANJALI
