
A top police officer told that two intruders were trying to sneak this part of the fence. The security forces challenged them to return back, however they refused, resulting into exchange of fire, the officer said.

## PDP's Srinagar candidate Waheed Para booked for poll code violation

SRINAGAR: PDP candidate from Srinagar Lok Sabha constituency Waheed Para has been booked for violating Model Code of Conduct (MCC) by holding a road show without prior permission in south Kashmir's Pulwama last month, offi-

cials said on Thursday. The Srinagar constituency went to polls on May 13, registering about 38 per cent voter turnout which was the second highest in the past three decades. Para is among 24 candidates in the fray from the seat

The officials said the FIR was lodged against Para on May 8 under section 188 (disobedience to order duly promulgated by public servant) of the Indian Penal Code at Pulwama police sta-

tion on the complaint lodged by nodal officer, MCC and additional deputy commissioner, Pulwama.

The PDP leader is accused of holding a road show in the Padgampora, Larkipora, Goripora, Wankanpora. Dangerpora, Jangalnad. Dhawatoo, Batapora, Khandaypora and Panzgam in Pulwama on April 27, without any permission from the authorities concerned.

Quoting a report of senior superintendent of police, the complainant said the vehiclebound rally of Para from PDP office to circular road via Rajpora Chowk, Murran and Peaks crossing was in violation of the MCC.

The candidate violated the MCC despite requests
