Women's College Batpora, Zakura organises Annual Cycle Race



Public Notice

With the notification of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 by Government of India and subsequent notification of Jammu Municipal Corporation, Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws, 2019, it is incumbent / compulsory for all waste generators including households, shops, commercial establishments, Hotels, Institutional Establishments, vegetable / fruit / flower mutton / meat markets etc. to segregate waste at source and also to strictly ensure management, segregation, recycling and reuse of Municipal Solid Waste strictly as per aforementioned rules.

"Fine" means penalty imposed on waste generators or operators of waste processing and disposal facilities under the byelaws for non-compliance of the directions contained in these rules and/or bye- laws.

If any waste generator, who fails to comply with the duties entrusted upon himunder rule 4 of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, shall be liable to pay fine under these bye-laws. The quantum of fine shall be imposed in accordance with the offences mentioned in theSchedule.

The general public through the medium of another notice is again informed to fine / Penalty for incompliance of Solid Waste Management rules 2016 within limits of Jammu Municipal Corporation as per the following rates:
