CRIMEREPORT

6 vehicles seized, 6 persons arrested for Illegal extraction & transportation of minerals

KULGAM: Cracking a whip on illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, police have seized 06 vehicles and arrested 06 drivers in Kulgam.
Acting swiftly upon the specific information generated from credible sources regarding the transportation of illegal mining minerals in the jurisdiction of Police Station Qaimoh, multiple teams headed by SHO Police Station Qaimoh established multiple checkpoints at Kwaki Bazar and Khudwani Bypass NHW-44. During checking, 06 vehicles including 03 Tippers, 02 Tractors and a Dumper involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals were seized. The drivers were arrested and shifted to police station Qaimoh where they remain in custody.
Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at Police Station Qaimoh and further investigation have been initiated.

Drug peddler arrested; Contraband substance recovered

6 bovine smuggling bids foiled, 49 bovines rescued, 6 vehicles seized

JAMMU: Police in Jammu District continuing its crackdown against against bovine smugglers under operation Kamadhenu, Police team of Police Station Nagrota foiled 03 bovine smuggling bid, rescued 23 bovines and seized 03 vehicle (1)Truck bearing registration No.JK14A/5419, and (2)JK02AH/9585 from Tavi bridge Sidhra and driver of vehicles fled away from the spot by taking advantage of darkness.
One more vehicle Truck bearing registration No Jk02AJ/9017 seized from Ban Tall

Plaza. Accused driver namely Mohd Shabir, son of Ghulam Rasool, resident of Kans Khassan Reasi was arrested on spot.
Moreover, 02 more bovine smuggling bid foiled by PS Jhajjar Kotli rescued 21 bovines and seized 02 (1)Truck bearing registration No.JK02AU/4456 and (2)JK20A/7240 which was going from Jammu towards Udhampur driver of vehicles fled away from the spot after taking advantage of darkness.
In this regard 5 FIRs No 151, 152, 153/2024 at Police Station Nagrota and FIR No.123, 124/2024 at Police Station Jhajjar Kotli were registered under relevant sections of law stands registered.
Investigation of all the cases are in progress.
Ghagwal Police also foiled bovine smuggling attempt and rescued five bovines from the clutches of bovine smugglers.
A Police team of Police Station Ghagwal headed by SHO PS Ghagwal while performing vehicle checking duty at NHW naka Tapyal, intercepted a Mahindra Pickup bearing registration No. JK19A-3171 coming from Kathua side for checking. During checking of the vehicle, five bovines were found laden inside which were tied in a cruel manner and were being transported illegally without any valid permission. All the rescued bovines has been shifted to safer place.
A case FIR No. 70/2024 u/s 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act has been registered at Police Station Ghagwal and investigation started.

Drug peddler with 4 grams of heroin
