It was informed that a 500 feet National flag is proposed to be installed at Suchetgarh. Directions were issued for facilitating bird lovers and tourists at Gharana wetland.

The Div Com further directed for development Jhajjar Kotli and organizing picnics for school students and promoting water sports at Ranjit Sagar Dam. He directed for publicizing the online booking for the jet ski facility at Basohli

and also promoting it as a pre wedding shoot destination. The Div Com directed the Sunisar- Mansar Development Authority to

extend the best facilities to tourists and publicize the view points for the public. Detailed discussion was also held for development of

tourist facilities and promotion of tourist sites in Reasi, Rajouri, Poonch, Doda and Kishtwar. Tourism department was

directed to prepare an activity calendar for festivals and tourist activities and to promote publicity materials as soft copy also.

Notice for Prohibiting Production, Stocking, Distribution, Sale & Use of Single Use Plastic (SUP) Items

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change has issued notification No G.S.R. 571(E) dated 12th August 2021 vide which manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of identified single use plastic (SUP) items shall be prohibited with effect from the July 01, 2022.

As per Rule 4(1) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), "The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1st July 2022:

(a) Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration;

(b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100micron, stirrers.

As per Rules 4(1)(c) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended) "Carry bag made of virgin or recycled plastic, shall not be less than one hundred and twenty (120) microns in thickness with effect from 31st December 2022."

This Notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Stockists, Retailers, Shopkeepers, e-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments(Malls/ Market place/ Shopping Centres / Cinema Houses/ Tourist locations/ Schools/Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items.

Any non-compliance in this regard will attract penal action as per Jammu & Kashmir Non-Biodegradable Material (Management, Handling and Disposal) Act, 2007 and as per its subsequent amendment by Government of India vide notification No. S.O. 1229(E) dated 31-03-2020 in above which may include fine up to the tune of Rs. 50,000/- and punishment for a term which may be extended for a month or both.

Applications on prescribed format are invited from the students resident of District, Rajouri for seeking admission in Class 6th for session 2024-2025 in Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) at Gurdhan Bala, Rajouri & Hubbi, Kotranka. 90% of the total seats are reserved for the ST students and 10% of the total seats are kept reserved for Non-ST Students wherein, preference shall be given to the children who have lost their parents due to insurgency, children of widow & children of specially abled parents.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Candidate should be pass out of the 5th class from a Govt/Recognized Private School during the session 2023-24 or the candidate should be reading in class 6th during the current session
2. Candidate must have been born between 31-03-2011 to 31-03-2014 (both days included)
3. 90% of the total available seats are kept reserved for ST students and 10% of the total seats are kept reserved for non-ST candidates as mentioned above.
4. The total number of seats available for admission are 60 (30 Girls and 30 Boys)

Selection Procedure:-

1. Candidate shall have to appear in the EMRS selection Test (EMRSST) for seeking admission in class 6th.
2. The EMRS Selection Test (EMRSST) shall comprise of 100 Multiple Choice questions with four options for each question. Each question will be awarded 01 mark and there will be negative marking @0.25 marks per question.
3. Total time duration of examination will be of two (02) hours.
4. The EMRS Selection Test (EMRSST) shall be based on Mental ability questions, Arithmetic question and language.
5. The venue of the examination shall be notified separately. The tentative date for conduct of EMRS Selection Test (EMRSST) shall be notified separately. There shall be EMRS Selection Test (EMRSST) in case, the number of applications received is less than the number of available seats (Total No of Seats=60, Boys=30, Girls=30)
6. In case of the tie at the cut off merit the selection shall be made through Draw of Lots.

1. The selected candidates will be provided free Boarding/lodging/Uniform/Text Books /Stationary material and all other facilities which shall be admissible from time to time in accordance with the EMRS guideline, issued by the Government from time to time.
