Modi dares Congress to restore Article 370 in J&K

JUNAGADH GUJARAT Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Thursday challenged the Congress to restore Article 370 in Jammu-Kashmir, abolish the Citizenship Amendment Act (CAA) and the law that bans triple talaq.

"I have buried Article 370. It is gone now. I want to challenge the Congress' royal family and its 'shehzada' (a jibe at the Gandhi family and Rahul Gandhi) that if it is your hidden agenda, then come out in the open and tell people you will restore Article 370," he said at a poll rally in Junagadh in Gujarat.

"I want to see how much courage they (Congress) to insult the Constitution drafted by Babasaheb Ambedkar. You (Congress) will fail because this (standing in your way) is Modi." the PM asserted.


Stop registering voters for beneficiary schemes under guise of surveys: EC to political parties
