Following the meeting, the Director also inspected the ongoing work at Panchayat Ghar Chanderkot and directed the contractor to complete the project by June 15th.

Officials said a police team was on patrolling duty on Tuesday when during routine

frisking in Dharamsal area, a man was found to be using banned VPN on his mobile phone.  
During investigation, it was found that Mohammed

Dishan of Brehvi area of Kalakote tehsil had downloaded and installed three VPN softwares on his phone, thus violating the district magistrate's order, they said.
