JAMMU: The third day of the Inter-Departmental Cricket Tournament 2025-26 for Men, organized by the University of Jammu, witnessed high-octane cricketing action and impressive displays of skill and sportsmanship.

Held at the University Cricket Ground, the tournament saw enthusiastic participation from students representing various academic departments.

Organized under the patronage of the Chairman, Campus Sports Committee, JU, the event has garnered overwhelming support from across the campus. It aims to foster camaraderie, physical fitness, and a spirit of healthy competition among

The tournament is being conducted under the overall supervision of Dr. Daud Iqbal Baba, Chairman, Campus Sports Committee, and is coordinated by Raj Kumar Bakshi, Incharge PTL, Campus Sports Committee.

In the first match of the day, the Department of Distance & Online Education (DD&OE) registered a commanding win over the Geology Department by a margin of 108 runs. DD&OE put up a strong total of 180/5 in their allotted 15 overs, thanks to brilliant perform-

ances by Vikshay, who scored 53 runs and took 2 wickets, and Dinesh, who contributed 42 runs. The Geology Department, in response, could only manage 72/6 in 15 overs, with Ujjwal top-scoring with 27 runs.

The second match featured a nail-biting contest between the Economics Department and the Political Science Department. Economics emerged victorious by a narrow margin of just 3 runs. They posted a total of 138/4 in their 15 overs. Political Science fought hard but fell short, scoring 135/6 in their innings, making it one of the most thrilling encounters of the tournament so far.

In the final match of the day, the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management (SHTM) displayed dominance over the Zoology Department, winning by a convincing 79 runs. SHTM scored 145/5 in

15 overs, with standout performances from Anirudh, who scored 48 runs, and Ishtaiq, who notched up 51 runs. The Zoology Department was bowled out for just 66 runs, unable to counter the strong bowling attack.

The matches were officiated by a panel of experienced officials including Vijay Kumar, Ashok Singh, Raj Kumar Bakshi, and Anirudh Singh, who ensured fair play and adherence to rules throughout the tournament.
