

Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyaan gains momentum in Kathua Distt; 9 villages host farmer-centric events

KATHUA: As part of the nationwide Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyaan 2025, a series of impactful awareness and outreach programmes were successfully launched on Thursday across three blocks in Kathua district, reinforcing the spirit of "One Nation, One Farmer, One Team."

In a coordinated effort to empower farmers with timely, field-specific knowledge and promote innovation-driven agriculture, three villages in each of the blocks Kathua, Huggain, and DingaAmb hosted comprehensive programmes on the first day of the campaign. Dr Vishal Mahajan and Jatinder Kumar Khajuria have been nominated as district Nodal officers for the event. Three joint teams at district level have been constituted with team leaders viz. Dr. Anamika Jamwal, Chief Scientist, KVK Kathua, Dr. Vishal Sharma, Scientist KVK Kathua. The team members from the agriculture and allied departments included Ravi Sharma, DAO (Extension), Satvir Singh District SMS, Kuldeep Kumar District SMS, Bharat Bhushan Pangotra District

Horticulture Officer and officers from Animal and Sheep Husbandry Department. Further the joint teams have been constituted at block level under the supervision of Sub-Divisional Agricultural Officers, Horticulture Development Officers and officers from other line departments.

Member of the Legislative Assembly from Billawar Satish Kumar Sharma, actively participated in Kohag panchayat of Kathua district. Addressing a large gathering of farmers, MLA Sharma emphasized the importance of timely dissemination of information as a critical factor for success during the Kharif season. He noted that informed decision-making regarding crop selection, pest manage-

ment, irrigation techniques, and fertilizer application can significantly boost productivity and income for farmers. He further added that "This campaign is a major step toward transforming Indian agriculture. It ensures that our farmers are equipped with the latest scientific knowledge at the right time, which is essential for a successful Kharif crop."

Speaking at the programme in Jakhbar, Chief Agriculture Officer, Kathua Jatinder Khajuria, highlighted the various on-going schemes of agriculture and

allied sector. in the district officials emphasized the campaign's objective of building a self-reliant agricultural ecosystem through direct farmer-scientist interactions. Dr. Vishal Mahajan, Head KVK Kathua emphasized that these programmes are instrumental in transforming traditional agriculture by infusing science, technology, and localized solutions. Our goal is to ensure no farmer is left behind," said a representative from the District Agriculture Department.

Live demonstrations, question and answer sessions,

and awareness drives on soil health cards, climate-resilient practices, and government schemes formed part of the day's events. The initiative will continue across all blocks of Kathua district until June 15, 2025, covering all 19 blocks in the coming days. The Department of Agriculture, Kathua, encourages farmers to attend upcoming events in their respective areas and avail expert guidance that can help maximize yields and ensure sustainable livelihoods.
