ABVP Jammu Kashmir demands release of pending scholarships for students under PMSSS

JAMMU: Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP) Jammu Kashmir has demanded the immediate release of pending scholarships for students pursuing undergraduate studies outside the state under the Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme, administered by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).

As per the scheme, eligible students from Jammu and Kashmir are provided scholarships, including tuition fees and hostel fees, to pursue their UG studies outside the state. However, students of the 2023-24 batch, currently in their 4th semester, have received scholarships only for the 1st and 2nd semesters, with no scholarships released for subsequent semesters.
