operation/registration of the face book account as referred above on your name. 11. Whereas, upon the confirmation of your antecedents, the designated enquiry officer initiated the proceedings of departmental enquiry and you were contacted

telephonically by his office for serving you the summary of allegations, so framed. 12. Whereas, during this conversation, you disclosed that the above referred face book account has now been blocked and communicated another active/operative mail ID
