

DC Reasi reviews performance of Health Deptt

REASI: Deputy Commissioner Reasi Nidhi Malik on Friday chaired a comprehensive review meeting of the Health Department to assess the status of ongoing health programmes and initiatives in the district.

Chief Medical Officer Dr. Mohammad Ashraf Kohli, provided an overview of the department's functioning in the district including Maternal and neonatal healthcare, Family Planning and immunisation and a briefing on the 100-Day TB Elimination Campaign.

The Deputy Commissioner laid special emphasis on Maternal and neonatal Healthcare and instructed the Chief Medical Officer (CMO) to furnish detailed data on institutional deliveries and home births. She emphasized the need to minimize home deliveries, highlighting the risks these pose to both mothers and newborns. The DC Reasi urged health officials to ensure that all deliveries take place in registered healthcare institutions, where proper

medical support is available, to enhance the overall safety and outcomes of childbirth in the district.

For improving child healthcare, the Deputy Commissioner emphasized on the significance of the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK). She directed the CMO to ensure early detection and prevention of diseases among children, so that timely treatment and support can be provided to them.

It was informed that the district has improved many parameters like ANC registration touching 91% in the first trimester of 2024-25 in comparison to last year's 80%, institutional deliveries reaching 91% during 2024-25, BCG Vaccines

rate recorded at 108% and considerable improvement in PPIUCD insertion.

The Deputy Commissioner stressed that the hilly, inaccessible, remote areas of Mahore, Reasi & Pouni, where people still resort to home deliveries need to be given special attention. She asked for conducting Block wise monthly review of implementation of each Programme. She further directed the officials to compile monthly health data and furnish the same to her office.

The meeting also included a briefing on the 100-Day TB Elimination Campaign, a focused initiative to raise community awareness around TB prevention and treatment.

DC Poonch reviews working of FCS&CA Deptt

POONCH: Deputy Commissioner Vikas Kundal chaired a review meeting here on Friday to assess the working of the Food Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs Department.

Assistant Director FCS&CA Adil Shabir and all Tehsil Supply Officers (TSOs) of the district attended the meeting.

At the outset, the Assistant Director FCS&CA gave a detailed presentation regarding the functioning of the department. He said that the district has ample stocks of essential commodities including wheat, rice, LPG, petrol and diesel.

A thorough discussion ensued and the DDC reviewed the status of e-KYC/e-Shram/NFSA/Non-

NFSA & PMFSS schemes focusing on three categories of Non- Priority Households (NPHH), Priority Households (PHH) and Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY). He reviewed the current status and issues faced by the TSOs from various zones in the district.

The DDC reviewed E-KYC reports from each zone and asked the TSOs to complete the E-KYC registration in their jurisdictions. He also discussed issues related to online transactions, instructing officers to only provide ration through online mode. Manual or offline ration provision is not permitted only in areas having network issues. The Assistant Director was asked to review the network location of the offline PoS Machine again.

- Whereas, on 13.05.2023, while your posting in F-Coy of this unit, you were found absent in evening roll call conducted by then BHM of this unit HC Abdul Rashid No. 212/IRP-18th Bn. PID No. ARP985528.
- Whereas, you were accordingly marked absent in unit daily diary on 13.05.2023 vide DD report No. 21.
- Whereas, later on in view of your continuous absence from duties, the below mentioned communications were made by Coy Commander F-Coy of this unit with your concerned Police station intending to inform you to rejoin the duties.
 - CC F-Coy/IRP-18th/2023/147 dated 11.10.2023.
 - CC F-Coy/IRP-18th/2023/157 dated 02.11.2023.
 - CC F-Coy/IRP-18th/2023/172 dated 24.11.2023.
- Whereas, when the above referred communications failed to get any response from your side, simultaneously an attendance notice against you was issued vide this office letter No. Estt/IRP-18th/PF-803/2023/20987-88 dated 07.10.2023 and dispatched to your official recorded residential address at Chatha Farm Jammu through a special messenger of this unit namely Sgt. Kuldeep Singh No. 458/IRP-18th Bn.
- Whereas, during the process of serving the attendance notice at your residential address, it was revealed that your family has shifted from the said area to any other location, as a result of which the said notice could not be served upon you.
- Whereas, in order to verify your new residential address, a communication vide this office letter No. Estt/PF-803/IRP-18th/2024/6569-72 dated 24.04.2024 was made with the Spl. DG, CID J&K, Jammu for verification of antecedents and the status of your present residential address.
- Whereas, in response the Spl. DG, CID J&K, Srinagar vide his office signal No. CID/GB/Abs-25/2024/7267 dated 11.06.2024, communicated that during the course of verification so conducted through the concerned field staff of the organization, it came to fore that your father has sold out his whole property at Chatha Farm Jammu and has shifted somewhere in Mohali Chandigarh, besides intimating that you have gone abroad to New Zealand, as disclosed by your father on Cell No. 9419139688.
- Whereas, on the receipt of the above referred information and in view of your prolonged absence, you were placed under suspension vide this office Order No. 168 of 2024 dated 10.10.2024, with the initiation of a departmental enquiry against you to be conducted by Sh. Satvinder Singh-DySP, Quarter Master of this unit.
- Whereas, you were meanwhile found active on social media face book account titled Nainjot Singh URL [www.facebook.com/profile.php ? ID 100080412385560](https://www.facebook.com/profile.php?id=100080412385560) operative in Melbourne Victoria, Australia.
- Whereas, in order to establish any contact with you, the above referred face book ID was got verified through concerned security agency which confirmed the operation/registration of the face book account as referred above on your name.
- Whereas, upon the confirmation of your antecedents, the designated enquiry officer initiated the proceedings of departmental enquiry and you were contacted telephonically by his office for serving you the summary of allegations, so framed.
- Whereas, during this conversation, you disclosed that the above referred face book account has now been blocked and communicated another active/operative mail ID titled singhhenry200@gmail.com for facilitation of future communications.
- Whereas, the designated enquiry officer accordingly served the summary of allegations upon you through the above referred mail ID on **06.03.2025 at 10:55 AM** with the directions to respond to its contents in YES or NO.
- Whereas, on 12.03.2025 at 6:47 PM, you responded to the contents of the above referred communication with the admission of levelled allegations.
- Whereas, on 17.04.2025 at 2:15 AM, you again furnished a document on official mail ID of this unit (co-irp18th@jkpolice.gov.in) submitting therein that you are not interested to serve the department anymore and have taken the decision without any external force/pressure.
- Whereas, in view of your continuous absence and expression of your disinterest to continue your services, the designated enquiry officer concluded the proceedings of departmental enquiry and has submitted his findings recommending your **Removal** from Govt. services.
- Whereas, you were appointed in the department on 24.02.2020, with probation period of (03) years, and it was obligatory for you to qualify it within its prescribed period. However, as yet you have failed to qualify your probation, besides have evaded to undergo BRTC at 03 occasions by way of unauthorized absenteeism. Apart from this, it has also been established that you have left the country (India) without seeking prior permission of the department which gives enough reason/material to discharge you from the Govt. services in the light of existing rules of your employment.

Though, the above discussed facts are enough to dispose off the instant departmental enquiry in light of the existing rules of the department for the act of your prolonged absence, admission to the guilt and your desire not to serve the department anymore received by this office through your Email ID singhhenry200@gmail.com. However, it has been felt imperative to afford you another opportunity to be heard before taking any final decision on the act of your prolonged absenteeism, subsequent to your decision of not serving the department. Therefore, I Raj Singh Gouria-JKPS, SSP Commandant IRP-18th Bn. in terms of Rule 359 (2) J&K Police Manual call upon you through the medium of this Show Cause Notice, to explain as to why you shall not be **Discharged** from the Service in terms of Rule 187 and 339(a) J&K Police Manual for your repeated/continuous absence from duty and the failure of completing your probation within a prescribed time, besides leaving the country without prior permission of the department. Failing to respond to the contents of this notice within a period of (07) days, it shall be presumed that you have nothing to justify your service misconduct and the action as warranted under rules shall be taken against you.
