JAMMU: Addressing a gathering of farmers, youth, and entrepreneurs during "Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan" in the border area of R.S.Pura sector near here, Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh said that over the last 11 years, Prime Minister Narendra Modi prioritised border areas and sought to do away with the terminology "Last Village" to replace it with "First Village" vision, placing border development at the heart of nation's growth

The Minister emphasized that this paradigm shift in the mind-set and approach towards the aspirations of citizens in remote and border

He also spotlighted tulip cultivation-once seasonal, now being harvested off-season. The CSIR-Srinagar is poised to lead cultivation of saffron and marigold, opening new vistas in floriculture.

Underlining the role of cutting-edge science, Dr. Singh announced that biotechbased value addition projects will enhance the shelf life of produce, with a notable rise in apple production and SHG involvement.
