AKHNOOR: Sahib Bandgi's revered Sadguru Madhuparamhans Maharaj, while delivering his spiritual discourse in Akhnoor on Sunday, captivated the congregation with profound insights about the immortal country from where the soul originates. Sadguru emphasized that the true homeland of the soul is beyond the physical realm, a divine country without earth, sky, water, air, or any of the five elements. "Wherever there are five elements, there is Pralaya (destruction)," he explained. "Elements give birth to elements and elements destroy elements."

He highlighted that the saints throughout history have carried the message of that immortal country. "Whatever Paltu Sahib said, it was Sahib's words. Whatever other saints said, they were also Sahib's words," he noted, acknowledging how the teachings of saints like Paltu Sahib and Kabir Sahib have echoed the same divine truths, albeit in their own expressions.

"Paltu Sahib tells us there is no water, no wind, no earth, no sky in that country. This is



Sahib's message," Sadguru Ji elaborated, underscoring that even sacred texts like the Vedas cannot fully describe this divine realm. "Even gods and the ten incarnations do not reach that country. No Siddha or meditative master can meditate there." Sadguru Ji further explained that while many have spoken about Sat Lok (the eternal realm) after reading scriptures, only a true saint who has experienced it firsthand can truly convey its essence. "The Satya Lok that I am talking about-I truly go there," he affirmed. "That's why Sahib said: 'You are talking about what you have read; I am talking about what I have seen with my own eyes.'"

He urged the congregation to seek the truth beyond written words and to embrace the direct experience of the divine through spiritual guidance.

Devotees present expressed deep reverence and gratitude for the enlightening discourse, leaving with renewed inspiration to walk the path of truth and inner realization.

## DC Kishtwar convenes public outreach camp

KISHTWAR: To strengthen institutional governance and streamline the delivery of public services, Deputy Commissioner (DC) Rajesh Kumar Shavan today organized a Public Outreach Camp in Block Dachhan.

The camp witnessed enthusiastic participation from the local populace, who engaged actively with the district administration.

The DC provided valuable insights and guidance on various government schemes and initiatives, including the JK Samadhan Portal, Mission Yuva Scheme, Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan, Water Kuhl Development, Women Empowerment Programs, and other centrally sponsored schemes.

During the session, the DC issued a series of directives to the concerned departments for improving public services in the area.

The BDO Dachhan was Directed to ensure the functionality of all abandoned drains, achieving 100% man-days generation under MGNREGA. The Ex En PWD R&B was directed to submit road estimates to ensure no area is left unconnected.

The ARTO Kishtwar was directed to organize awareness camps for transporters and drivers in the region.

The Ex.En Jal Shakti Kishtwar was tasked with expediting JJM works, ensuring timely completion of reservoirs, establishing filter plants,

and revamping old water supply schemes.

PMGSY authorities were directed to undertake road widening from Dangdaro to Sounder, construct two new culverts, and carry out blacktopping works at an accelerated pace.

Concerned departments were instructed to prioritize the renovation of school buildings and the completion of languishing projects.

The DC also assured the public that issues raised during the camp would be addressed with due diligence. He emphasized the administration's commitment to responsive and inclusive governance.

Further, the DC shared that skill development courses are now open for registration and encouraged unemployed youth to enroll. He announced that an Employment Awareness Camp would soon be organized at Block Dachhan.

Additionally, directions were issued to ensure timely compensation for fruit-bearing and non-fruit trees, as well as land compensation.

The DC also presented baby care kits to the mothers of newborns under Beti Bachao Beti Padhao initiative.
