CRIME REPORT

Drug peddler arrested, 1.7 Kg poppy straw recovered

AWANTIPORA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate menace of drugs, Police on Tuesday arrested a drug peddler and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Post Reshipora under the supervision of SDPO Awantipora Mumtaz Ali Bhattachi at a checkpoint established near Braw Bandina intercepted a suspect identified as Sajad Ahmad Pala, resident of Braw Bandina. During search, 1 Kg & 700 gm Charas like substance was recovered from his possession. He was arrested and shifted to police station where he remained under custody. Accordingly, FIR No. 135/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Awantipora and investigation started.

Three theft/ snatching cases solved; 6 arrested, stolen items recovered

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday solved three theft/snatching cases solved by arresting six accused persons and recovered stolen items including a bike, two scooters, two mobiles and 17 chairs.

As per details, a team of Police Station Bishnah recovered stolen items and arrested thieves /snatchers involved in theft/snatching cases. A complaint was lodged at Police Station Bishnah by one Sunny Kumar, son of Baldev Singh, resident of Preet Nagar Hoshiarpur, Punjab stating that some unknown persons snatched his bike along with 2 mobile sets and 20 plastic Chairs, which he was carrying on bike for selling purpose. On this, FIR No. 108/2022 under section 382 of IPC was registered at Police Station Bishnah and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Bishnah under the supervision of SDPO R S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Bishnah Pawan Kumar Dogra, after putting in strenuous efforts and with help of CCTV footages of the area, rounded up three suspects later identified as Sukhdev Singh, son of Joginder Singh, resident of Chama Kulli, Hoshiarpur, Punjab at present Kothi Morh; Lovely Singh, son of Govind Singh and Angrez Singh, both residents of Kothi Morh; Tehsil Bishnah. During sustained questioning, the accused confessed their involvement in crime and on their disclosure stolen items were recovered which include a motorcycle Discover (Rs 55,000 approximately); 17 plastic chairs (Rs 10,000 approximately); two Mobile sets (Rs 32,000 approximately). Total value of recovered items was Rs 97,000 approximately. Similarly, a written complaint was lodged at Police Station Pacea Danga by one Amit Gupta, son of M R Gupta, resident of Talab Tillo, Jammu regarding theft of his Scooty from Olympic Association Office, Parade. On this, FIR No. 66/2022 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station Pacea Danga and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Parade under the supervision of SDPO North Sharad Kallu led by SHO Pacea Danga Insp Raghuraj Singh assisted by Incharge Police Post Parade SI Lalit Kumar, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded-up a suspect namely Amit Sharma, son of Prabhu Dutt, resident of Bhagvati Nagar, Jammu. During questioning, accused confessed his crime. It is pertinent to mention that the he also confessed that he had stolen another scooty from Nanak Nagar Jammu (JK02BP-8920). On his disclosure both the stolen scooters were recovered. Similarly, a written complaint was lodged at Police Post Narwal by one Nitish Sharma, son of Sham Lal Sharma, resident of Narwal Bala, Jammu regarding theft at his 5 medical shops at Narwal main mar-



ket, Jammu. In this regard, FIR No. 158/2022 under sections 457/380 of IPC was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Post Narwal under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafri led by SHO Bahu Fort Insp Nayat Ali assisted by Incharge Police Post Narwal SI Achal Rana, after putting in strenuous efforts, rounded up two suspects. During questioning accused confessed their involvement in crime and on their disclosure stolen cash along with other stolen items were recovered. The accused were identified as Raju Massi, son of Naku Massi, resident of Sector-C, Sainik Colony, Jammu and Mohan Raj, son of Nanak Chand, resident of Bakal Reasi.

Youth nabbed with 135 psychotropic capsules, intoxicating powder

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday arrested a youth and recovered 135 psychotropic capsules along with intoxicating powder from his possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Gharota led by SHO Gharota Insp Rajesh Khajuria while on Naka duty rounded up a suspect namely Hardeep Singh, son of Jagjit Singh, resident of Bhour camp, near Central Jail Kot Bhalwal Jammu. On search, 135 psychotropic capsules and white powder suspected to be some intoxicating medicine were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No. 57/2022 under section 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Gharota. Intensive questioning is going on to know about his other accomplices. The overall arrest and recoveries were made under the supervision of SDPO Akhnoor Varun Jandial.



6 vehicles seized for illegal mining

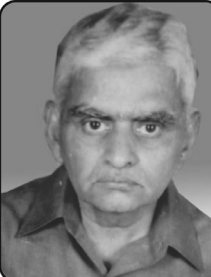
