

**CRIME REPORT**

**Three narco-smugglers nabbed with heroin**

RAMBAN: Police on Thursday nabbed three narco-smugglers and recovered 6 gm heroin from their possession.

As per the details, a party of Police Station Ramban headed by SHO Inspector Sandeep Charak while Naka checking, intercepted one Tata Tiago (JK19 6950) driven by Baljeet Singh, son of Raj Gopal Singh, resident of Suligam Ramban and two other accomplices in the car namely Reyaz Ahmed, son of Mohd Shafi, resident of Tatarsu Ramban and Arbaz Khan, son of Mohd Shafi, resident of Chamba Seri Ramban who were coming from Maitra towards Ramban. During checking of the car, 6 gm of Heroin(Chitta) like substance was found from the dash board of the car. Further, they disclosed that they were carrying the contraband for selling purpose and for illegal smuggling. Trio was arrested and FIR No. 227/2022 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against them at in Police S Ramban. The overall Operation was carried out by police party headed by Insp Sandeep Charak under the supervision of Pardeep Singh Sen DySP Hqrs Ramban with the overall supervision of SP Ramban Mohita Shama.



**Theft case solved; 2 arrested, stolen property worth Rs 1.5 lakh recovered**

NOWSHERA: Police on Thursday solved a case of thefts by arresting two accused and recovered stolen property worth around one and a half lakh rupees from their possession.

In an official statement, Police said that on 13 June, Police Station Nowshera received a written complaint lodged by Suresh Kumar son of Jangbahadur Singh Choudhary to the effect that some unknown burglars have stolen his motorcycle bearing registration number JK11D 0411 from parking area Nowshera during the intervening night of 12 and 13 June. Following the receipt of this information, a formal case was registered at PS Nowshera with FIR No 132/2022 under relevant sections of law and investigation was set into motion to trace out the accused person and recover the stolen property. During investigation SHO Nowshera Rajesh Jasrotia assisted by PSI Manish identified a number of suspects based on technical exercise and each suspect was put to sustained questioning under the supervision of SDPO Nowshera Tussif Ahmed.



After hectic efforts of police party of PS Nowshera, two suspects namely Irfan Sadiq son of Sadiq Hussain resident of Ward No.13 Nowshera and Haroon Mirza son of Mohd Hussain resident of Rajal Top, Nowshera were zeroed in and based on their disclosure the stolen property, a motorcycle, with registration number JK11D 0411 was recovered.

SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam said that investigation and working out cases of thefts is a prime priority of police in order to recover and return the hard earned money of people but there is need to have a preventive approach from all stake holders in the society to avert the incidents of thefts.

**Notorious drug peddler & chronic bovine smuggler detained under PSA**

RAMBAN: Police on Thursday detained a notorious drug peddler & chronic bovine smuggler under PSA.

As per the details, Mohd Rafi, son of Firoz Din, resident of Village kumfer, Tehsil & District Ramban has been detained under Public Safety Act (PSA) by the Order of District Magistrate, Ramban. The accused is a notorious drug peddler & chronic bovine smuggler. He committed several attempts to promote the illegal trade of bovines and narcotics in distt Ramban. The accused was a notorious criminal and one of the sympathisers & well-wisher of drug peddlers and spoiling young generation activities within the jurisdiction of Distt Ramban and the surrounding areas. The accused was instigating the people of Chanderkote area especially the youth to consume drugs. The accused is also a history sheeter and is involved in a number of cases of police station Chanderkote. The oblique motives of the subject was to enhance drug peddling and bovine smuggling to earn easy money. His activities had the potential of igniting the cycle of drugs in the UT of J&K, as such was detained under J&K PSA vide Order No. 16-PSA of 2022 which stated that the accused Mohammed Rafi, son of Firoz Din, resident of Village Kumfer, Tehsil & Distt Ramban be detained and lodged under Public Safety Act in Central Jail Kot Balwal, Jammu.



**Police rescues 4 stranded persons**

BASANTGARH: Police on Thursday rescued four stranded persons from Nadani Top. As per the details, a distress call was received by the Station House Officer (SHO) of Basantgarh Police Station Inspector Sohan Singh last morning. The caller informed about a lightning incident took place at Nadani Top, snow laden spot in which one person died and 4 others (reportedly Scheduled Tribes) have been injured.

Accordingly, after receiving information, Inspector Sohan Singh, SHO Basantgarh swung into action, and a rescue team was formed on the directions of SSP Udhampur, Vinod Kumar and SDPO Rannagar, Bhisdm Dubey from the Police personnel of Police Pickets Lodhra, Porara, Kadhwa and Sang alongwith locals of the area nearest to the spot which rushed to the spot in incessant rains. The search and rescue party found it difficult to reach on the spot due to continuous rains but managed to reach at the spot after covering a distance of 30-35 Kms on foot in 7 hours, crossed swollen Nallahs especially Ujj with the help of ropes and wooden planks and shifted 4 injured person and 1 body to SDH Basantgarh in the mid night where they were given first aid and other medical facilities. The whole rescue operation was directly supervised by SSP Udhampur and well-coordinated by SDPO Rannagar with the rescue party led by Inspector Sohan Singh, SHO Basantgarh.



**3 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized**

**Missing brother-sister traced, reunited with family**
