HFDC robbery case: Police issues lookout notice against absconding accused

JAMMU: A lookout notice has been issued against one Sukhvinder Singh after his name figured as an accused in the HDFC Bank robbery of Rs 1.65 crore in Jammu's Kathua, Police officials said on Friday.

Sukhvinder Singh's link to the bank robbery surfaced after the Kathua police succeeded in arresting one accused on June 21.

The police, besides recovery of Rs 1.53 crore from him, also got to know about Singh who was still absconding.

Police in its notice stated, "As such, description and the photograph of wanted accused is being circulated with the appeal that anybody having information about his whereabouts may contact us on below given Phone Numbers/E-mail ID- viz. 130 spurious plastic paint buckets seized

KATHUA: Police on Friday seized 130 spurious plastic paint buckets at



Kathua. As per the details, on receiving a complaint from the complainant namely Neelash Kumar, son of Rama Shish Mahutu, resident of D 21 East Vinod Nagar, Delhi regarding certain individuals who were engaged in the manufacture, stocking, printing and selling spurious

products under the name of Asian Paints near Sanji Morh. Acting on the same, a special team of Police Post Marheen was constituted under the overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal, led by PSI Swaran Singh Manhas under the close guidance of SDPO Border Pankaj Soodan alongwith agent of Asian Paints (The Intellectual Property Right Enforcement Cell) raided different hardware shops near Sanji Morh. While on checking specifically at "Krishna Fertilizer Hardware Store" near Sanji Morh said team was able to seize 130 duplicate/fake plastic paint buckets costs around Lakhs which were being sold on the name of "Brand Asian Paints.

On questioning owner of the shop (Krishna Fertilizers & Hardware Store) namely Krishan Lal, son of Om Parkash, resident of Marheen stated that he purchased all above buckets from Billion Paint Industries Sna Road Industrial Area Ludhiana. Meanwhile all the recovered 130 duplicate/fake paint buckets were seized and on this instant case vide FIR No. 132/2022 U/S 420/IPC, 63/65 Copyright Act has been registered at PS Rajbagh while further investigation was set into probe.

3 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police teams of Police Station Arnia and Police Post Talab Tillo acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 3 different vehicles involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicles include 2 Tractor Trolley without Registration No seized by Arnia police and one tipper (JK02BB-5466) by Talab Tillo police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Arnia Inspr Devinder Singh and In-Charge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Rajesh Kumar in their respective jurisdictions.

2 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substances recovered

SRINAGAR: Police in its recent action against drug dealings in Sopore & Bandipora on Friday arrested two drug peddlers and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

In Sopore, police Station Bomai received a specific information through reliable sources that one person namely Nasir Akbar Wani son of Muhammad Akbar Wani resident of Tujjar Shareef Sopore has hoarded & concealed Narcotic substances. On receipt of this information, a police team from Police Station Bomai headed by SHO PS Bomai intercepted and apprehended the accused drug peddler at a checkpoint established at Bun Astan Tujjar Shareef. During search, officers were able to recover 105 grams of Charas like substance from the accused drug smuggler. He has been shifted to PS where he remains in custody.

In Bandipora, Acting on a specific information, police Party of Police Station Bandipora led SHO PS Bandipora under the supervision of

DySP Hqrs Bandipora, laid a surprise checkpoint at Sheikh Mohalla Bandipora. During checking, police party intercepted 02 suspicious persons who on seeing police party tried to escape from the spot but alert party apprehended a person identified as Mohammad Shafi Sheikh resident of Sheikh Mohalla Bandipora. However the other person identified as Mohamad Ashraf Sheikh resident of Sheikh Mohalla Bandipora managed to escape from the spot, efforts are on to effect his arrest. During search, 70 grams of Charas, 04 illicit liquor & 03 Beer bottles were recovered from his possession. The accused has been shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective Police Stations and investigation have been initiated.

2 unauthorised medical stores sealed

RAMBAN: Drug Control Officer (DCO) Ramban, Intiyaz Ahmed on Friday conducted an extensive inspection in the far flung area of Khari.

He inspected several medical shops in Khari and adjoining areas.

During the inspection, the DCO sealed 2 medical stores on the spot for violation of various provisions of Drugs and Cosmetic Rules 1945.

Statutory drug samples of 02 drug formulations were lifted from the market particularly from far flung areas for determining the strength and purity. These samples will be referred to the Drug Testing Laboratory for framing legal opinions to ascertain their quality parameters.

Further, it was impressed upon the chemist fraternity to follow the provisions of Drugs and Cosmetic act and rules in letter and spirit, failing which the department shall be constrained to initiate action against the violators.

The Drug Inspector requested the people of such areas to co-operate with the department to identify persons/Medical Stores indulging in drug peddling and selling intoxicating drugs to the youth. He also shared the Phone No./Whatsapp No with the Locals/People to report about the unethical trade practices.

Three missing persons traced; reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Friday traced three missing persons and reunited them with their families.

As per the details, an information was received about two missing persons namely Muzahir Ahmad, son of Shahnawaz Ahmad and Javed Ahmad, son of Mohd Din, both residents of Behmadasa, Ramban at present Bathindi Jammu regarding which FIR No 164/2022 under section 363 IPC was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort.

An input was received regarding the missing children in RS Pura area. After this, teams under the supervision of SDPO R.S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO PS R S Pura Insp. Rajesh Sharma did hectic efforts and traced the missing persons.

Meanwhile Rehmble Police also traced a missing girl within 7 hours and reunited her with family. The parents of the girl resident of Garhi area lodged her missing report .

Security forces conduct mock drill at Yatri Bhawan Jammu

A mock emergency situation was made where various teams were to deal with the possible situation in their own unique way but at the same time in coordination with other teams. Drill was performed successfully under the supervision of SP Ops Naresh Singh flanked by SHO PS Nowabad Inspr Vijay Kumar assisted by In-Charge Police Post Canal Road PSI Amreek Singh. Other than these many senior officers of Indian Army, CRPF also supervised the mock drill. Team of Indian Army( 4th Grenadier ) was led by Capt. Pandey, Team of CRPF by II IC Deepak including QRT of 38th Bn, QRT of 76th Bn, QRT of 160th Bn, team of SDRF(10 men) by Ashok Kumar, team of Fire Brigade(5 men) by Surjeet Singh. Moreober an ambulance was kept in ready situation for treating any casualties as a part of mock drill.
