CRIME REPORT

Three pickpockets arrested, cash & documents recovered

SRINAGAR: Police on Saturday arrested three pickpockets in Srinagar and recov-ered stolen cash and documents from their possession.

As per the details, Police Post Hazratbal received a written complaint from Sarfraz Ahmad Haroon son of Nazir Ahmad Haroon resident of Dhoobhigat Hazratbal to the effect that some pickpockets had stolen his cash and some essential documents.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR 85/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered in PS Nigeen and investigation was initiated.

During the course of investigation, investigating team by using all available means were able to arrest three pickpockets who have been identified as Bilal Ahmed Panoo son of Gh Mohd Panoo resident of Palhalan Pattan, Fidah Ahmad Khanday son of Gh Mohd Khanday resident of Parihaspora Pattan and Bilal Ahmed Sofi son of Bashir Ahmad Sofi resident of Dal Colony Bemina.

Stolen cash and documents have also been recovered from their possession.

Factory involved in illegal manufacture/processing of beer sealed

SRINAGAR: Acting tough against illegal manufacture/processing of Beer, police along with civil authorities have sealed a factory in Khummoh area of Srinagar.

As per the details, acting on specific information received from reliable sources that a factory registered in the name of M/S Zainab Textiles situated at Phase-2 Khummoh is involved in illegal/unlawful activity of manufacturing/processing of Beer.

Accordingly, a party of Police Station Panthachowk under the supervision of SDPO Panthachowk alongwith officials from Excise department, Revenue department and Food department raided the suspected spot. During search, large quantity of beer bottles was recovered and was accordingly seized on spot. The machine used in the manufacturing process has also been seized.

In this regard a cased vide FIR No. 64/2022 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Panthachowk and investigation has been initiated.

Drug peddler arrested; psychotropic substance recovered

BUDGAM: Continuing its efforts to remove the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Saturday arrested a drug peddler & recovered psychotropic substance from his possession.

As per the details, a party from Police Station Chadoora at a checking point established near Govt. Hr. Secondary School Panzan intercepted a vehicle bearing registration number JK04F-0682. On checking, 66 bottles of Chlorpheniramine Maleate & Codeine Phosphate based syrup (Controlled drug) was recovered from the vehicle. The vehicle used in the commission of crime has been seized and the drug peddler identified as Firdous Ahmad Wani son of Ghulam Ahmad Wani resident of Chadoora was arrested.

Accordingly, a case FIR number 117/2022 under relevant sections of NDPS Act stands registered at Police Station Chadoora & investigation has been taken up.



Three held with banned drugs, illicit liquor

KATRA: Continuing the drive against illicit liquor and drug abuse launched by District Police Reasi under supervision of Amit Gupta, Senior Superintendent of Police Reasi, Reasi Police on Saturday arrested 3 liquor smugglers and drug peddler and recovered 1000 capsules of Tramadol and 480 tablets of Alprazolam from their possessions.

As per the details, a team of Police Station Katra led by Insp Nishant Gupta SHO Katra under supervision of Kuljeet Singh SDPO Katra during the routine checking of vehicles and pedestrian at Katra area, arrested two person namely Darshan Lal, son of Krishan Lal, resident of Panjar Tehsil Moungri District Udhampur and Tarsem Lal, son of Raji Ram, resident of Chakhad Tehsil and District Jammu and recovered 9 bottles of alcohol from their possession. Duo was arrested and FIR No 180/2022 under sections 188 IPC was registered against them at Police Station Katra.

In another incident, a team of Police Station Katra under overall supervision of Amit Bhasin SP Katra arrested one drug peddler namely Sunil Kumar, son of Yashpal, resident of MH Road Command Hospital Udhampur along with 1000 capsules of Tramadol and 480 tablets of Alprazolam from their possessions.

FIR No. 181/2022 under sections 8/21/22 of NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Katra.

Two narco-smugglers nabbed with 2.9 Kg Ganja

JAMMU: Continuing it's drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jammu Police on Saturday nabbed two narco-smugglers and recovered 2 kgs 950 grams of Ganja from their possession. As per the details, a team of Police Station Channi Himmat constituted under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari and led by SHO Channi Himmat Insp. Deepak Katoch while on Naka duty in the area, rounded up two suspects namely Sunny Masih and a woman. During search, 02 kgs 950 grams of ganja was recovered from their possession.

Duo was arrested and FIR under relevant sections was registered against them at Police Station Channi Himmat.

2 JCBs involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams of Police Posts Phallian Mandal and Chatha acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 2 vehicle involved in illegal mining.

The seized vehicle include, JCB (PB06AZ-7192) seized by Phallian Mandal police and another JCB (JK02CW/4227) by Chatha Police.

The recoveries were made by In-Charge Police Posts Phallian Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal and Chatha SI Ranjit Singh Chib in their respective jurisdictions.

88 bovines rescued, 5 smugglers nabbed

JAMMU: Police on Saturday foiled various bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 88 bovines and arrested 5 smugglers. As per the details, during Naka checking, a team of Police Station ThanaMandi intercepted one Truck (JK02AT 0665) and one Junga (JK11F 5872) who were found loaded with 11 and 9 bovines respectively. Both the vehicles were on way towards Buffliaz with out any permission from DM .

All the bovines (20) were rescued and two smugglers namely Mohd Mahroof, son of Musa, resident of Kassi Pata Reasi and Bilal Ahmed, son of Ibrahim, resident of Badakana Thanamandi were arrested. FIR no 89 & 90/2022 under sections 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act were registered against them. The arrests were made by team of Police Station Thanamandi led by SHO Insp Mohd. Shoket under the supervision of SDPO Thanamandi Dr. Intiyaz Ahmad.

Meanwhile, a team of Police Station Ramsoo intercepted a truck (JK-03G-8279) driven by driver namely Amir Hussain Malik, son of Mushtaq Ahmed Naik, resident of Brinal lambar Teh-Devsar ,Distt-Kulgam which was on his way from Jammu towards Srinagar. During checking, it was found loaded with 30 bovines which were rescued. The driver was arrested and FIR No 71/2022 was registered against him in Police Station Ramsoo. The overall rescue operation was made by police parties under the command of Insp Nayeem Ul Haq SHO Ramsoo, PSI Arun Thakyal under the supervision of Nissar Khoja SDPO Banihal with the overall supervision of SP Ramban, Mohita Sharma.

In another action, a police team led by In-Charge Police Post Tikri PSI Abdul Satar under the supervision of DySP Hqrs. Udhampur Sahil Mahajan during routine Naka/checking duty in its jurisdictional area noticed few persons/ groups enrouted from Tikri towards Kashmir Valley side in connection with smuggling of bovines. On thorough checking 38 bovines were found which were being taken by foot without any legal permission. Thereafter, all the 38 bovines were rescued and 2



bovine smugglers namely Mohd. Younis, son of Jamal Din, resident of Jammu and Hamidu, son of Mirza, resident of Jammu were arrested on spot. 2 FIRs under relevant sections of law were registered in Police Station Rehambal.

ADC, Tehsildar, JE among 10 persons injured in scuffle; 7 arrested

SRINAGAR: At least ten persons including Additional Deputy Commissioner, Tehsildar were injured in a scuffle between the Revenue official and locals at Laroo village area of Kulgam district.

As per the details, a scuffle broke out between some locals of Laroo and Tehsildar after the Deputy Commissioner (DC) Kulgam, Dr.Bilal Mohi-Ud-Din- Bhat visited Laroo village along with teams of officers of R&B and Revenue department In order to complete the land acquisition process for National Highway -444 project in a set timeframe However during this visit a group of local people attacked the team of Officers/ Official on visit and at least 10 persons including ADC kulgam/Tehsildar Kulgam, JE were injured in a scuffle between the Revenue and R&B official and locals at Laroo village area of Kulgam district on Friday.

As the attack on Tehsildar led to scuffle, some other employees of R&B and Revenue also received injuries. All injured persons admitted in district hospital Kulgam for treatment.

Dy. Superintendent of Police Kulgam GM Bhat said that the matter is under investigation and 7 person has been arrested so far.

Theft case solved, accused arrested, stolen items recovered
