# CRIME REPORT

## 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

JAMMU: In a quest to stern the menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which police team of Police Station Miran Sahib and Police Post Phallian Mandal acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicle include 3 dumpers without Registration No seized by Miran Sahib police and one tractor (JK02BS 8220) by Phallian Mandal police.

The recoveries were made by SHO Miran Sahib Inspr Zaheer Mushtaq and In-Charge Police Post Phallian Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal in their respective jurisdictions.

## Drug peddler nabbed with 31 Challis of Charas

JAMMU: Police on Sunday nabbed a drug peddler and recovered 31 Challis of Charas from his possession.

As per the details, an input was generated by the sleuths of DSB Jammu regarding drug smuggling in the area under the jurisdiction of Police Police Sidhra. On this, a team of Police Post Sidhra under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar led by SHO Nagrota Inspr. Vishva Pratap Singh assisted by In-Charge Police Post Sainik Colony PSI Bhawani Singh along with the teams of DSB Jammu did strenuous efforts and rounded up one suspect later identified as Shabir Ahmed, son of Abdullah, resident of Dedha Tehsil Gool Distt. Ramban. On search 31 Challis of Charas weighing 7.16 grams were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No 269/2022 under section 8/20 NDPS Act was registered in Police Station Nagrota.

## Abducted girl rescued, accused arrested

JAMMU: Police on Sunday recovered an abducted girl and arrested the accused. As per the details, one complaint was lodged at Police Station Channi Himmat, by the legal heirs of a girl, stating that she got missing from her respective home. In this regard case FIR got registered and investigation got started. On this, a police team under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafri led by SHO Channi Himmat Inspr Deepak Katoch did hectic efforts and with the help of CDR analysis tower location, and CCTV footage of the area, successfully traced out the minor abducted girl within 24 hours from the accused person namely Angrez Chand, son of Rattan Chand, resident of Dani Rajbagh Kathua, who abducted the said girl. Subsequently accused got arrested and family of the missing girl was informed and the traced girl was handed over to her respective family members after completing all the legal formalities.

## 4 missing persons traced, reunited with families

JAMMU/SRINAGAR: Police on Sunday traced four missing persons and reunited them with their families.

As per the details, On June 19, 2022 a missing report was entered at Police Station Billawar by one of the family member of missing woman stating therein that his wife resident of Najote Tehsil Lohai Malhar District Kathua alongwith her baby went missing from her home. Acting on the missing complaint said woman was traced today. While in another instance one more missing report was entered at Police Station Kathua on June 11, 2022 about a woman resident of Govindsar District Kathua who went missing from her home. All efforts were made out by the family members but the whereabouts of the missing couldn't be ascertained. Acting on the complaint search was started to trace her out and with the continuous strenuous efforts, coupled with technical assistance a Kathua police traced her. Thereafter both the traced women were immediately handed over to their legal heirs after completion of all legal formalities.

In another instance, two boys who were missing from Dolipora, Kawdara Nowhatta since few days were reunited with their families today.

In a tweet Srinagar Police wrote, " Two missing boys were traced & reunited with families by Nowhatta Police Station. These boys (names withheld) were missing

from last one week from Dolipora, Kawdara Nowhatta. Their missing had caused lot of apprehensions & fear in minds of families in particular and society in general."

Pertinently many videos were in circulation on social media where parents of missing boys were seen appealing for their safe return.

## Two theft cases solved; 2 arrested, stolen items recovered

JAMMU/SRINAGAR: Police on Sunday solved two thefts case solved by arresting two accused persons and recovered stolen Items recovered on their disclosure.

As per the details, on June 23, 2022, a written complaint was lodged at Police Post Talab Tillo by one person namely Rinku Sharma, son of Baldev Raj Sharma, residents of Friends Lane pertaining to the theft at his rented house at Friends Lane Talab Tillo Jammu.

On the receipt of this information, FIR No. 73/2022 under section 454/380 IPC was registered at Police Station Nowabad and investigation started

After this, a team of Police Station Nowabad under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Swati Sharma led by SHO Nowabad Inspr Vijay Sharma assisted by In-Charge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Rajesh Kumar did strenuous efforts and after connecting various leads along with timely human intervention rounded up a suspect namely Nikhil Verma, son of Raj Kumar Verma, resident of H. No. 78 Bakshi Nagar Jammu who upon sustained questioning, confessed his involvement in the above case and on his disclosure, stolen item A HP laptop, A syska Trimmer and A Sunglasses was recovered from his possession. Moreover one more lenovo Stolen Laptop recovered from his possession.

Srinagar Police also solved a theft case by arresting one accused person involved in the commission of crime and recovered stolen property worth lakh from his possession.

As per the details, On June 21, 2022, Police Station Shaheed Gunj received a written complaint from a female stating therein that some unknown burglars entered into her rented room located at Dadi Kadal Zaindar Mohalla and stole Gold jewellery and cash. Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 51/2022 relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Shaheed Gunj and investigation was set into motion.

On receipt of this information, a special team was constituted and during the examination of technical evidences and CCTV footages near the place of occurrence, an accused person was identified who was involved in the commission of crime. After strenuous efforts, the accused person identified as Younis Ahmad Mir son of Mohammad Shafi Mir resident of Shah Mohalla, Ahmad Nagar, Srinagar was arrested from Vatakalo, Chadoora Budgam.

On his disclosure stolen property which include Gold Jewellery worth Rs 6,00,000, cash amount of Rs 3,15,000/-, 2 Mobile Phones worth Rs 50,000/-, 3 Hand watches worth Rs 30,000/-, 3 Power banks worth Rs 15000/-, Camera (Sony) worth Rs 15,000 and a Sound Box worth Rs 1,000/- (Total recovery worth Rs 10lakh approx) were recovered from his possession which he had kept inside his rented room located at Buchwara Dalgate.

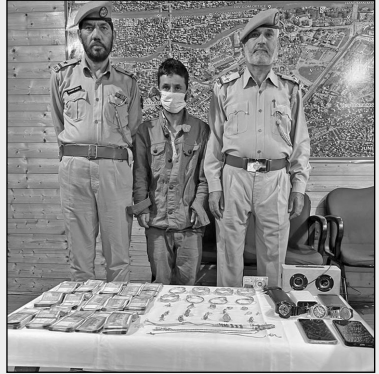
Further investigation of the case is going on and more recoveries are expected.

## Drug peddler arrested, contraband substance recovered

## Bootlegger nabbed with 10 ltrs of illicit liquor

KATHUA: In its recent action against the consumption/production of illicit liquor menace in the District, Kathua Police under the overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal on Sunday seized 10 Litres of illicit liquor alongwith 01 person was arrested at Chak Drab khan Kathua As per the details, an information was received from the reliable source that illicit liquor is manufactured near Chak Drab Khan and its adjoining areas. Acting swiftly, a team of Police Station Kathua led by PSI Arjun Singh under the supervision of DySP Headquarters Kathua Shammii Kumar during special checking/ patrolling duty in said area noticed one suspicious person who was doing the trade of preparing/selling illicit liquor to people of Chak Drab khan near Khad in order to gain illegitimate profit. On physical checking, approximately 10 litres of illicit liquor was recovered from the possession of one person namely Mangal Singh alias Munna, son of Kartar Chand, resident of Mirpur Jaggo Tehsil Nagri & District Kathua. The accused was arrested and FIR No. 250/2022 under section 48(A)/ Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station Kathua.



## Hardcore criminal detained under PSA
