Withdraw anti-youth 'Agnipath' scheme immediately: Congress

KATHUA: In response to the nationwide call given by party high-command against the anti-youth "Agnipath" scheme, a massive protest was organised by Congress workers under the leadership of senior Congress leader and former MLC Thakur Balbir Singh at Barwal in newly created Jasrota assembly segment of Kathua district. A large number of Congress workers attended the impressive rally organized by senior party leader Amrit Singh Jasrota. Former legislator Thakur Balbir Singh addressed the protest demonstration against the BJP government over the Agnipath scheme and termed the scheme as a cruel joke to the youth of the country. While terming the "Agnipath policy" as anti-youth, Singh demanded its immediate roll back to pacify youth who have been protesting across the country.

Singh pointed out that youth all over the country are protesting against this policy but the government appears to be not ready to accept the reality and adamant to implement this scheme. Thakur Balbir Singh lambasted BJP for its failures on all fronts, especially in giving employment. He reminded that BJP has promised two crore jobs annually and one rank one pension but betrayed youth and ex-servicemen. "What to say providing job to the unemployed youth of the country, BJP led government is snatching employment", Singh observed. He exhorted Congress workers to oppose the anti-people policies of the government. Congress workers protested against the Agnipath scheme seeking its roll back and opposed dictatorial policies of BJP politics besides highlighting other anti-youth, anti farmers, and anti-labour policies of BJP and UT administration.

Congress workers raised slogans against the anti-people policies of the BJP government, and demanded roll back of anti, anti farmers and anti-people policies.

124 vaccinated, 1,393 samples collected in Ramban

RAMBAN: As per a report issued by the District Immunization Officer, Ramban, Dr. Suresh the Health Department administered the vaccination to 124 persons in the district. Continuing the enforcement drive to implement Covid protocol across the district Ramban, the Enforcement teams today fined scores of violators for roaming without wearing face masks and not maintaining physical distance. The Enforcement officers urged the people to wear face masks and maintain physical distance besides taking Covid vaccination doses at their nearest CVC. As per daily bulletin issued by the Chief Medical Officer, Ramban, the Health Department has collected 1393 samples including 435 RT-PCR and 958 RAT samples besides administering Covid vaccine to 124 persons at various dedicated Vaccination Centres in the district.
