During the course of visit, Dulloo also launched the plantation activities of department by planting a sapling of citrus plant in the nursery. He also inaugurated the Hi-Tech Poly House developed in an area of 2000Sq.m. for production of quality plant material.

Speaking on the occasion, Atal Dulloo appreciated the work done by the depart-

ment in developing the mega nursery on scientific lines. He impressed upon the officers to work with more zeal and zest for producing maximum number of quality plant material at the nursery so that the common farmer is benefitted.

Dulloo asked the officers to aware maximum people about the high tech activities of the department so

that they can take maximum advantage out of it and can produce quality fruits which eventually will uplift their economic conditions.

Director Horticulture Jammu, Ram Sevak briefed the ACS about the developmental works going on in the nursery for its holistic development covering an area of 805 Kanals. He

informed that the nursery will be developed with latest technologies for production of quality true to type High Density fruit Plants of Mango, Guava, Litchi, Citrus etc.

Pertinently, the mega nursery is being developed will be first of its kind in the history of department exclusively for the production of cultivars of high density fruit plants. The nursery will cater the requirement of high density fruit plants of farmers of Jammu province to a greater extent.

Director Agriculture Jammu, Joint Director Horticulture Jammu, Chief Horticulture Officers, District Level officers, HDO's, and other staff was also present on the occasion.

SRINAGAR: In order to finalize the arrangements for pilgrims of Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra (SAJY)-2022 at Yatra Transit Camp (YTC), Panthachowk, the Deputy Commissioner (DC) Srinagar, Mohammad Aijaz Asad on Monday undertook a visit to the venue.

On the occasion, the DC inspected the E-KYC centre established for RFID tags to be provided to the officials and yatries visiting Transit Camp Panthachowk during their halt.

The DC also took stock of the functioning of the Food

Langars established at the camp. He interacted with the Langar functionaries.

Earlier, the DC inspected the recently constructed pre-fab huts, public convenience facilities, First aid and Health camp, Water Management, installation of Stalls by Handicrafts Department and local SHGs for the upcoming annual Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra-2022.

While inspecting the newly constructed Prefabricated structures for stay of the Yatries during their halt, the DC directed the R&B authorities to make all required arrangements with

regard to bedding in these stay halls.

The DC asked the Departments to keep provisions for extra arrangements at the Camp to tackle any exigent situation so that Yatries do not face any difficulty. The DC was further informed that all necessary arrangements with regard to drinking water and electricity facilities have been made in advance at the halt camp.

While more than 50 water tanks have been installed in the camp. He was further informed that about 100 mobile washrooms and more than 50 mobile urinals have been kept.

With regard to sanitation and cleanliness facilities, the officers of Srinagar Municipal Corporation were directed to ensure proper sanitation and cleanliness in the transit camp on a regular

basis, besides deployment of sufficient staff at the camp for periodical cleanliness in and around the transit camp every day.

The DC was informed that about 250 mobile toilets and over 70 mobile wash rooms have been kept available at the Transit camp for the convenience of the yatries, in addition to newly constructed prefabricated public convenience facilities.
