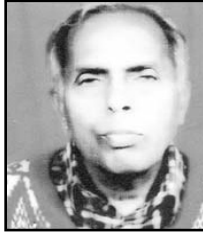

CRIME REPORT

3 arrested with 50 Kg Trillium Govanianum

HANDWARA: Police on Monday arrested 3 persons along with an endangered trillium govanianum medicinal herb in Qalamabad, Handwara. As per details, a party from Police Station Qalamabad at a checkpoint established at Lach Qalamabad, intercepted a vehicle (JK09-2155) with 3 persons onboard, who were identified as Shafiq Ahmad Khan, son of Ali Mohd & Reyaz Ahmad Khan, son of Aziz Rehman Khan, both residents of Mankal and Jameel Ahmad Mir, son of Gh Mohd, resident of Chak Sanzipora.

During search, police recovered endangered medicinal herb Trillium Govanianum (local name Tri Pattri) weighing around 50 Kg from their possession. They were arrested and shifted to police station where they remained in custody. The vehicle used in the commission of crime was also seized. Accordingly, FIR No. 39/2022 under relevant sections of law was registered at Police Station Qalamabad and investigation started.

Three killed in mishaps

JAMMU: Three persons got killed in separate mishaps on Monday.

As per details, a bike met with an accident in Parlah area, due to which three youth-borne got injured. They were shifted to hospital where doctors declared one of them as brought dead. The deceased was identified as Rohit Kumar, son of Roshan Kumar, resident of Parlah. In another incident, Pawan Singh, son of Ramesh Singh, resident of Billawar, presently staying at Narwal got hit by a bike in Bhatindi area on June 23, and was undergoing treatment at GMC Jammu, but he succumbed to injuries.

Meanwhile, Arafat, son of Mohd Qasim, resident of Rajouri also got hit by an unknown vehicle in Bhindi Jamal area and died at hospital during treatment.

Two die under mysterious circumstances

Missing youth's body found from Tawi river, family alleges murder

JAMMU: A youth, who went missing from Saturday, was found dead in Tawi river, however family has alleged it as murder.

As per details, Mohd Yunus, resident of Beli Charana, made a phone call to her sister on Saturday that when he was coming home on bicycle, some youth in a car were chasing him and as such, he is coming by foot through Tawi river side. When he didn't reach home, his parents started searching him along Tawi river. His parents alleged that they searched for their son for last three days and thereafter found his body from river. They further disclosed that despite making a complaint with police, nothing was done. The burn marks on the body prove that he was murdered, they alleged.

Kathua bank robbery case: Absconding accused nabbed

KATHUA: Police on Monday arrested second accused involved in Kathua bank robbery case and recovered about Rs 1.5 lakh from his possession. According to details, investigating robbery case, police arrested an accused on the very next day of incident and stolen money was recovered from him. During his interrogation, he revealed association of another accused namely Sukhwinder Singh, resident of Kathua. A lookout notice was also issued against him by the police. On Monday, police arrested him from a hideout.

Theft case solved, stolen bus recovered

JAMMU: Police on Monday solved a theft case and stolen bus was recovered by a team from Police Post Nehru Market Jammu.

As per details, a written complaint was lodged at Police Post Nehru Market by one Babu Singh, son of Balbir Singh, resident of Akhnoor stating that his bus (JK02AV-9292) has been stolen from warehouse parking area, after which FIR no. 155/2022 under section 379 of IPC was registered at Police Station Gandhi Nagar and investigation started. A team of Police Post Nehru Market under the supervision of SDPO South Sachit Sharma led by SHO Gandhi Nagar Inspr Pankaj

Sharma assisted by Incharge Police Post Nehru Market SI Rohit Gandhi, with help of CCTV footages from different locations, traced out stolen bus from Katra.

4 vehicles seized for illegal mining

JAMMU: In a quest to stern menace of illegal mining, a multi-pronged strategy was devised by Jammu Police in which teams from Police Posts Pounichak, Panjthirthi and Chatha acted stringently on specific inputs and raided at a location in their respective area and seized 4 vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles include 2 tractor trolleys without registration numbers seized by Pounichak police; a dumper (JK02CV-6994) seized by Panjthirthi police and a tractor-trolley bearing engine No NKF2TBE0309 seized by Chatha police. The recoveries were made by Incharge Police Posts Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria, Panjthirthi PSI Rahul Sharma and Chatha SI Ranjit Singh Chib in their respective jurisdictions.

51 bovine rescued, 2 trucks seized

RAMBAN: Acting tough against bovine smugglers and to curb bovine smuggling menace in district Ramban, Police acting on the specific inputs regarding transportation of bovines, teams of Police Station Ramban intercepted 2 trucks, one with registration number JK14F 7661, which was found loaded with 22 bovines while 29 bovines were recovered from other truck (JK02BR -9717). Both the trucks were seized and FIR Nos 233 & 234/2022 under sections 188 of IPC and 11 of PCA Act was registered in Police Station Ramban and investigation started. The overall rescue operation was made by police parties under command of Insp Sandeep Charak SHO Ramban under supervision of Pardeep Singh Sen DySP HQ Ramban and overall supervision of SSP Ramban, Mohita Sharma.

Two kidnapped minor girls rescued within 24 hours; 2 accused arrested

JAMMU: Police on Monday traced out two kidnapped minor girls within 24 hours and arrested two accused persons in this regard.

Giving details, SSP Jammu Chandan Kohli said that two incidents of abduction of minor girls were reported at Police Stations Bahu Fort and Channi Himmat, against which FIR no 95/2022 was registered at Police Station Channi Himmat while FIR no 170/2022 got registered at Police Station Bahu Fort under relevant sections of law and investigation started. Different parties were constituted under supervision of SDPO city East Jammu Zaheer Abbas Jafri headed by SHO Insp Nayat Ali of Police Station Bahu Fort and SHO Insp Deepak Katoch of Channi Himmat, which after putting in strenuous efforts and analyzing CCTV footages, traced out an abducted girl from Lakhampur and while other was recovered from Amritsar. Two accused were also arrested by police.
