Youth found hanging with tree

The deceased has been identified 20 years Karan Singh, son of Khajur Singh, resident of village Meer. His family has alleged murder however, Police is investigating the matter.

Scooty rider snatches phone from migrant labourer

Woman killed, 4 injured as car rammed into truck in Kathua

KATHUA/JAMMU: A 60-year-old woman was killed and her four relatives seriously injured on Tuesday when their private car rammed into a parked truck in Kathua district, police said.

The accident took place at Rajbagh on Jammu-Pathankot highway when the driver lost control over the car and hit the truck stationed on the roadside, a police official said.

He said five persons travelling in the car were seriously injured in the accident and were rushed to Government Medical College (GMC) hospital, where Chanchal Gupta, a resident of Chadwal, was declared brought dead.

Drug peddler arrested; contraband substance recovered

BUDGAM: Acting tough against drug dealing, Police on Tuesday arrested one drug peddler and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per the details, during the course of investigation of case FIR No. 117/2022 of PS Chadoora, investigating team arrested one more drug peddler identified as Arifat Ahmed Yatoo son of Mohammad Maqbool Yatoo resident of Dalipora Nagam in the instant case. Officers also recovered 5.5Kgs of Poppy Straw and 01 Bottle of Codeine Phosphate from his possession.

Pertinent to mention here that the said drug peddler was arrested on the revelation of already arrested drug peddler namely Firdous Ahmad Wani son of Ghulam Ahmad Wani resident of Chadoora who was arrested on 26/06/2022 along with 66 bottles of Codeine Phosphate in the instant case.

4 excavators, 4 dumpers involved in illegal mining seized

KATHUA: To contain the menace of illegal mining, District Mineral Officer Rajinder Singh along with field staff took action against defaulters for illegal mining in Bani areas on Tuesday.

The action was initiated on the complaints of local people of Bani about illegal operation and mining activities at Dagger Nallah and Bani Nallah. The team seized 4 heavy excavators and four dumpers from the twin sports. The illegal mining has also affected the aquatic life and flow of water in the Nallahs.

During the visit, deep pits and digging spots were found around crusher units where excavators were used for lifting minor minerals from the nallahs. All the tools and vehicles were seized on the spot by the District Mineral Officer.

After the seizure, the machinery and tools were kept in the possession of nearest police incharge Dhaggar and Bani on challans for further action as per the rules of Geology and Mining department. One more dumper carrying minerals without Form-A near Hutmaska was also penalized.

En-route, the team of the mining department also inspected different illegal mining spots in rivulets and nallahs of Basholi and Bani.

The team advised consumers to purchase minerals from legal sources only and stay away from illegal miners and illegal mining practices too. Deputy Commissioner Rahul Pandey has already instructed the mining deptt for tightening the noose around the violators.

94 bovines rescued; 9 arrested

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday foiled various bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 94 bovines and arrested 9 smugglers.

As per the details, a team of Police Station Mahore led by Insp. Karnail Singh SHO Police Station Mahore under the Supervision of Chabbail Singh SDPO Mahore laid surprise Nakas at Mahore area of District Reasi foiled three bovines smuggling attempts and registered 3 case FIRs No 67, 68 & 69/2022 under relevant sections in a night long operation against bovine smuggling and rescued 24 bovines from the possessions of 4 bovines smugglers namely Mohd Iqbal, son of Qadar Baksh, resident of Shikari tehsil Mahore District Reasi; Shoket Ali, son of Abdullah, resident of Shikari Tehsil Mahore District Reasi; Noor Mohd, son of Qadar Baksh, resident of Shikari Tehsil Mahore and Mohd Akram, son of Nazir Hussain, resident of Shikari Tehsil Mahore District Reasi.

Jhajjar Kotli Police also rescued 11 bovines animals from two vehicles during Naka checking. i.e 02 bovine animals in Auto Goods Carrier (JK02CF-9846) and 9 bovines in Truck (JK02U-0537) which were seized.

Two cases i.e Case FIR No.161 &62 /2022 under sections 188 IPC,11 PCA Act,50,52,54,56 Transportation of animals Rules 1978 were registered at Police Station Jhajjar Kotli and three accused got arrested.

The arrested accused have been identified as Latief Mohd, son of Qasim Din, resident of Chaddali Tehsil Damsal District Jammu; Surinder Singh, son of Bhajan Singh, resident of Mussatha RS Pura Jammu and Tanveer Ahmed, son of Ab. Rehman, resident of Faqirwani Baramulla. The overall arrest and recoveries were made under by team led by SHO Police Station Jhajjarkotli Inspector Vikram Sharma under the supervision of SDPO Nagrota Pardeep Kumar.

Meanwhile, On the directions of SSP Udhampur Dr. Vinod Kumar under the supervision of SDPO Chenani Ahmad Shaafi , a party of Police Station Chenani headed by Insp Om Parkash, SHO Chenani established a Naka at Zero Point, Motor Shed Chenani. During Naka checking, three vehicles carrying bovines, were intercepted and 59 bovines found loaded in these three trucks (JK02AR 8377, JK03D 9710 & JK21 1281) which were driven by driver Ashiq Hussain, son of Mushtaq Ahmed, resident of District Kulgam, and Jagdev Singh, son of Jageer Singh, resident of Shahpur were rescued which were being carried towards Kashmir Valley side.

Duo was arrested and FIRs bearing Nos. 111, 112 &113/2022 under section 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act was registered at Police Station Chenani.

Missing boy traced, reunited with his family

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday traced a missing boy and reunited with his family.

As per the details, an information was received at Police Post Gujjar Nagar regarding missing of a boy namely Manzoor Ahmed, son of Sultan Mohd, resident of Iehkot Teh and Distt Budgam at present staying at Gujjar Nagar from his home. In this regard, a missing report was registered at Police Post Gujjar Nagar and investigation got started. On this, a police team formed under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafri led by SHO Police Station Peermitha Insp Kirti Sharma assisted by In-Charge Police Post Gujjar Nagar PSI Ajaz Ahmed did hectic efforts and traced out the missing boy from Budgam area with the help of local police of the area.

Subsequently the family of the missing boy was informed and the traced boy was handed over to his respective family members after completing all the legal formalities.

Notorious drug peddler booked, detained under PSA

RAJOURI: Government authorities on Tuesday booked a notorious criminal and Narcotics smuggler under Public Safety Act and has detained the accused.

Police said that notorious drug peddler namely Haroon Rashid son of Abdul Rashid resident of ward 2 Rajouri was been booked and detained under PSA.

The accused was involved in FIR No 720/2018 under sections 8(a)/21/29 NDPS Act, FIR No 468/2020 under sections 8(a)/21/29 NDPS Act, FIR No 36/2022 under sections 8/21/29 NDPS Act of Police Station Rajouri and is notorious drug

peddler in Rajouri and also in adjoining areas and indulged in sale of drugs to youth.

He has been detained under PSA by the order of Divisional Commissioner Jammu after a detailed action report was submitted by district police office Rajouri with police station Rajouri headed by SHO Fareed Ahmed implemented the orders.

SSP Rajouri Mohammad Aslam said that taking action against people involved in narcotics trade is a prime priority of the police with a number of accused have been arrested in different cases in past and recoveries have been made.

He said that the detention of said notorious peddler is a clear reference of zero tolerance policy of Rajouri police towards narcotics peddling and more such action is to be taken in future.

Theft case solved; woman arrested, stolen jewellery recovered

After this, a team of Police Station Basohli under supervision of SDPO Basohli Shaziaa Akther led by SHO Basohli Inspector Rajinder Khajuria rounded up a suspect woman namely Rekha Devi, wife of Suraj Singh, resident of Gagrote Basohli who upon sustained questioning, confessed his involvement in above said case and on his disclosure stolen items including Golden Nath -01; Chameeli Nath -01; Mangal Suter - 1; Tika - 2; gold rings -8; Silver Payal - 2 pairs Weighted 52.500gms of worth rupees 2,69700 were recovered.

BSF jawan arrested for raping her own minor daughter

Former Ranji player's wife found hanging under mysterious circumstances

R S PURA: Wife of Former Ranji player was found hanging in her house under mysterious circumstances at R S Pura.

As per the details, Diva Mahajan, wife of Paranav Mahajan, a former Ranji Player, resident of Ward No 2 R S Pura was found hanging in store of third floor of her house. She used to stay at first floor and today after sending her kid 10 years old son Ketan to tuition disappeared as her maid didn't found her at house. Later after searching, maid found her hanging in store. She raised alarm upon which neighbours reached the spot and informed the police also.

On receiving information, a police team reached the spot and broke the door which was closed from inside. They shifted the body to SDH for postmortem and later handed over to family. Police has seized her mobile and started investigation under section 174. Pertinent to mention, Prnava Mahajan died of cardiac arrest during a marathon in Punjab this April.
