The appointment of the appointees shall be subject to the following conditions:-

- a. That the emoluments of the appointee shall be governed under S.O. 194 dated 17.06.2020 as extended vide government order No. 586 JK GAD of 2021 dated 17.07.2021.
- b. That the appointee shall give an undertaking in the shape of an affidavit to the effect that if on verification, genuineness of the qualification, migrant, domicile and category (if any) certificates from the concerned issuing authority are found fake/forged, the claim of the appointee for appointment shall be deemed to have been cancelled ab initio.
- c. The salary of the appointee shall be drawn and disbursed by the concerned Drawing and Disbursing Officer after receipt of satisfactory report in respect of documents as mentioned at (b).
- d. The appointment of the said candidates shall be governed by the Jammu & Kashmir Probationer (Condition of service, Pay and Allowances) and fixation of Tenure Rules 2020 notified vide S.O. 192 of 2020 dated 17.06.2020.
- e. The inter-seiority of the appointee shall be as per the order as it exist in the selection list as communicated by J&K Service Selection Board.
- f. The appointment and other terms and conditions shall be governed by SRO 412 of 2009 dated 30.12.2009 issued by Revenue Department.
- g. The appointment of the candidate shall be governed by the "New Pension Scheme" notified vide SRO-400 of 2009 dated 24.12.2009.
- h. The appointment is subject to the outcome of any writ petition (s), if any, pending before any court of competent jurisdiction.
