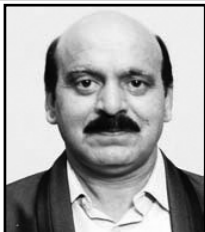

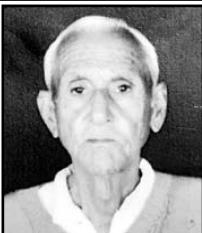

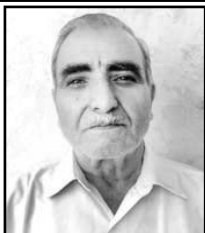

CRIME REPORT

4 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substance recovered

SRINAGAR: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Friday arrested 4 drug peddlers in Awantipora & Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

As per the details, in Awantipora, a party from Police Station Khrew at a checkpoint established at Wuyan near SICOP intercepted 02 suspicious persons. They have been identified as Umer Reyaz Ganie alias Jan Watab, son of Reyaz Ahmad Ganie and Umer Noor alias Umer Gola son of Noor Mohd Bhat both residents of Wuyan. During checking, officers were able to recover 20 grams of Heroin like substance from their possession. They have been arrested and shifted to Police station where they remain in custody.

In Baramulla, a police party led by SHO Police Station Sheeri under the supervision of DySP Hqrs Baramulla Syed Sajjad Hussain Bukhari-JKPS at a checkpoint established at Gantamulla intercepted 02 persons. They have been identified as Irfan Rasool Lone son of Ghulam Rasool Lone resident of Fatehgarh & Faisal Maqbool Tantray son of Mohd Maqbool Tantray resident of Zoogiyar. During search, 10 grams of Brown sugar & 82 grams of charas like substance were recovered from their possession. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and further investigation initiated.

Woman among three bootleggers nabbed; 40 litres, 52 bottles of illicit liquor recovered

JAMMU: In an act of alertness and prompt action, police on Friday nabbed three bootleggers including a woman and recovered 40 liters of illicit Liquor 52 bottles of illicit liquor from their possession.

As per the details, a team of Border Police Post Treva under the supervision of SDPO R.S Pura Surinder Singh led by SHO Arnia Insp. Devinder Singh assisted by In-Charge BPP PSI Pankaj Katoch did strenuous efforts and raided their location and finally rounded up two suspects in their respective areas. During search, 40 litres of desi illicit liquor along with utensils at village Marhol were recovered from two accused.

The identified as Sat Paul, son of Rahu, resident of Marhole and Renu Devi, wife of Dev Raj, resident of Marhole were arrested and FIR No. 48/2022 U/S 48(a,e) Excise Act and 49/2022 U/S 48 (a,e) Excise Act was registered against them at Police Station Arnia

Similarly another team of Border Police Post Baspur formed under the supervision of SDPO RS Pura Surinder Singh and led by SHO R S Pura Insp. Rajesh Sharma assisted by I/C BPP Baspur ASI Mohinder Singh while on Naka duty rounded up a suspect namely Bir Singh, son of Sansar Singh, resident of Vill. Abdal Teh.Suchetgarh. During search 52 bottles of illicit liquor were recovered from his possession. He was arrested and FIR No 107/22 under section 48A Excise Act was registered against him at Police Station R S Pura.

Missing woman traced, reunited with family

Two narco smugglers nabbed with heroin

73 bovines rescued; 2 smugglers nabbed
