


42 bovines rescued, 6 smugglers arrested**STATE TIMES NEWS**

REASI/KATHUA: Police on Saturday foiled various bovine smuggling bids by rescuing 42 bovines and arrested six smugglers.

As per details, a team from Police Post Malikote led by Insp Parmod Singh SHO Police Station Chassana under the Supervision of Chabail Singh SDPO Mahore laid a surprise Naka at Malikote and rescued 14 bovines from two bovine smugglers namely Mohd Akram, son of Mohd Younis, resident of Tulli and Mumtaz Ahmed, son of Mohd Younis, resident of Tulli, Tehsil Chassana. FIR No. 30/2022 under section 188 of IPC was registered at Police Station Chassana.

In another incident, a team of Police check Post Dharmari led by Insp Jeet Singh under supervision of SDPO Arnaas Pritpal Singh laid a surprise Naka at Sonchle Gali Near Dharmari and intercepted a Tata Mobile (JK-20A 8937) and rescued 5 bovines from two bovine smugglers namely Mohd Latief and Mohd Altaf, both sons of Mohd Ismail, residents of Wani Morh Mahore, Tehsil Mahore. They were arrested on the spot and FIR No. 81/2022 under section 188 of IPC 11(1)(A) of PCA Act was registered at Police Station Arnas.

Kathua Police under overall supervision of SSP Kathua R C Kotwal also rescued 22 bovines and arrested 2 smugglers near Tarnah area in Hiranagar. A team of



Police Station Hiranagar led by Insp Sunil Kumar under the supervision of SDPO Border Pankaj Soodan during Naka checking duty noticed some suspects indulged in transportation/smuggling of bovines by foot. The police rescued 23 bovines and arrested two smugglers identified as Zakir Hussain, son of Ali Hussain, resident of Chak Manga Gujriyan and Mohd Younis, son of Lal Hussain, resident of Barian Tehsil Vijaypur. FIR No. 74/2022 under section 188 of IPC was registered against them at Police Station Hiranagar.

Woman among two nabbed with over 42 Kg poppy straw

JHAJJAR KOTLI: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Jhajjar Kotli Police arrested two persons including a woman and recovered 42 Kg 160 gm poppy straw from their possession at Naka point Jhajjar Kotli.

The duo identified as Yora Singh, son of Darshan Singh, resident of Dholan, Ludhiana (Punjab) and Kulwinder Kour, wife of Pipal Singh, resident of Akbarwala Ferozpur, Fatehgarh (Punjab) was arrested and FIR No.131/2022 under sections 8/15/25/29 of NDPS Act was registered against them in Police Station Jhajjar Kotli. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SP Rural Sanjay Sharma.

Two drug peddlers nabbed with 10 Kg Ganja

JAMMU: Acting against the drug menace, Police has achieved a major success by recovering 10 Kg Ganja from two accused near Rajeev Nagar Chowk.

7 vehicles seized for illegal mining
