# Modi Govt discouraged policy of appeasement, in J&K: Sham Choudhary

R S PURA: A high-level team of Bharatiya Janata Yuva Morcha (BJYM) on Saturday held detailed interactions with the victims of discriminatory Article 370 and Article 35-A, including West Pakistan Refugees (WPRs), Valmikis and Gorkhas to obtain firsthand assessment of improvement in their lives post-abrogation of these laws in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

On the second-day of their Sushasan Yatra in Jammu Kashmir, the BJYM team comprising its National Media Incharge S.Amandeep Singh, BJYM State President Arun Prabhat and others visited border village Chakroi in R S Pura under Bharat Darshan Sushasan Yatra and held threadbare discussions with WPRs in the presence of former minister Sham Lal Choudhary.
