

Div Com reviews progress on JMRDA projects; discusses additional projects to be taken up

JAMMU: Divisional Commissioner Jammu, Ramesh Kumar, who is also the Additional Chief Executive Officer Jammu Metropolitan Region Development Authority (JMRDA), on Saturday, reviewed the progress of work on various projects executed under JMRDA here at a meeting with concerned officers.

It was informed that the main objective of the authority is to secure the orderly and planned development of the Metropolitan Region according to a Regional Development Plan. The Authority prepares Infrastructural Development Plan (IDP), for the maintenance of a responsible standard of livability in the JMR including Roads, water supply, sewerage disposal, drainage, electric-

ity, solid waste management, public transportation, parking and other amenities.

Preparation of Annual Action Plan for Infrastructure Development, Mobility Management Plan for Improvement and Upgradation of existing Transportation Network including roads, bridges, underpasses etc.

During the meeting the Div Com took stock of present status of ongoing projects including construction of Parking/

projects while some projects are at different stages of execution.

The Div Com directed all the concerned departments to expedite the pace of work on all the ongoing projects besides early floating of tenders of pending projects. He instructed the DCs to personally monitor the pace of work and also resolve land issues.

Deputy Commissioners apprised the Div Com about the proposals sent for the infrastructural development in their respective districts.

The Div Com also discussed preparation of plans for current financial year and asked the DCs and concerned departments to identify the works which could be included in the plan like development of parking spaces, development of rotaries, road connectivity, sew-

erage network etc. He also directed them to early submit the proposals/ DPRs after consultation with the executing agencies of their respective districts for timely approvals of the same.

The meeting was attended by Commissioner JMC, Rahul Yadav; besides officers of Urban Local Bodies, J&K Housing Board Jammu, Engineers of PWD, UCEED, Chief Architect J&K, Town Planners and other concerned while Deputy Commissioners of Kathua, Samba, Udhampur and Reasi attended the meeting through video conference.

Pertinently, the JMRD Authority covers 5 districts of Jammu division i.e Jammu, Reasi, Udhampur, Samba and Kathua including 30 tehsils and over 1107 revenue villages.

MVD launches drive across Jammu to check overloading, HSRP norms

JAMMU: A major enforcement drive was launched by MVD teams headed by the respective RTOs/ARTOs in the Districts for checking instances of overloading of passenger vehicles and enforcing compulsory affixation of High Security Registration Plates (HSRP) across different places of Jammu division. In Jammu District, a team of the officers of Motor Vehicles Department headed by ARTO BOI-G, Jammu Pawan Sharma conducted physical checking of Motor Vehicles under the supervision of RTO, Jammu at different places on the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway.

During the drive 187 vehicles were checked, out of which 43 vehicles especially passenger buses and Tempo Travellers which were destined to Bhaderwah, Kishtwar, Ramban, Banihal, Gander, Reasi and Udhampur were found either overloaded or loaded with goods in violation of Motor Vehicle

Act were challaned and compounded on spot. During the drive an amount of Rs. 1,32,000 was recovered by the violators onspot. In Samba District, a team of the officers of Motor Vehicles Department headed by ARTO Samba, Rehana Tabassum also conducted physical checking of vehicles at different places in the district Samba. During the drive 58 vehicles were challaned/compounded and fine to the of Rs. 37000 was realised from the violators from the spot and Rs. 18000 is expected from the remaining challans.

In Udhampur District, a team of the officers of Motor Vehicles Department headed by ARTO Udhampur, Jugal Kishore Sharma also conducted physical checking of vehicles at different places in the district Udhampur. During the drive 57 vehicles were challaned/compounded and fine to the tune of Rs. 14500 was realised from the violators from the spot and Rs. 1,90,000 is expected from the remaining challans. Doda District:

Similarly, MVD team headed by ARTO, Doda, Kuldeep Singh conducted physical checking of passenger and goods vehicles on Batote Doda Road and Doda Marmat Road. During the drive 92 vehicles were checked out which 27 vehicles were found either overloaded or without affixation of HSRP and challaned on spot.

In Reasi, Motor Vehicle Department headed by ARTO, Reasi, Rajesh Gupta conducted physical checking of Motor Vehicles on Katra Reasi Road. During the drive 05 vehicles were challaned for not affixation of HSRP and incomplete documents. Similarly, 05 vehicles were also seized due to deficient documents and without HSRP affixation. During the drive Rs. 6000 fine was also realised.

In Kishtwar, the team of the officers of MVD headed by ARTO, Ramesh Kumar Samotra conducted physical checking of the vehicles at different places. During the drive 12 vehicles were found violation of MV Act and without affixation of HSRP and fine to the tune

of Rs. 6000 was realised from the violators. In Rajouri, MVD headed by ARTO, Shammim Kumar Sharma conducted physical checking of the vehicles. During the drive, 26 vehicles were challaned and 13 vehicles offence were compounded and fine of Rs. 18000 was realised from on the spot.

In Ramban, Motor Vehicles Department headed by ARTO, Ramban, Shafiq Majid Bhat conducted physical checking of vehicles on NH44 and some other areas of Ramban and during the drive 28 vehicles were challaned/compounded and fine to the tune of Rs. 12100/ was recovered from the violation of spot.

In Kathua District, Motor Vehicles Department headed by ARTO, Neeraj Sharma under the supervision of RTO, Kathua conducted physical checking of vehicles. During the physical checking of 89 vehicles were challaned/compounded and a fine to the tune of Rs. 51,500 was realised from the violators onspot.
