"The Appraisal Committee shall send the list of selected good Samaritans to the Transport Commissioner for further payment of remuneration, through electronic mode," it added.

forest, or, in contravention of any rules made by the State in this behalf, kindles any fire, or leaves any fire burning, in such manner as to endanger such forest" does not allow such kind of activities," it stated and added, "Whereas Supreme Court of

India in the I.A. No.401 dated February 14, 2000 has also prohibited any non-forestry activities which are not part of management plan. In the sequel area within radius of 1.5 KM (aerial distance) from Main Chowk Patnitop stands declared as local area of Patnitop where all non-forestry activities are prohibited."
"This act of blatant use of fire in the environmentally sensitive zone & world-famous health resort is creating huge public nuisance, damaging natural resources/wealth and bringing bad name to the resort as well as Authority/Tourism Department," it stated and added "Now, therefore in exercise of powers conferred upon me under Section 133 Cr. P.C., I Sher Singh, KAS, Executive Magistrate 1st Class (Chief Executive Officer, Patnitop Development Authority) do impose complete ban on cooking, lighting of fire or burning of gas stoves, throwing of any kind of waste in the forest areas of Patnitop and around."
"Divisional Forest Officer Forest Division Udhampur; Divisional Forest Officer Forest Division Batote and Deputy Director Forest Protection Force Batote shall implement this order in letter & spirit. They shall make specific deployment of officers/officials of Forest/Forest Protection Force with name, designation & mobile Numbers at specific locations & assign them responsibility accordingly so that goal of fire free forest is achieved Khilafwarzi Wing of PDA, Officer(s)/Officials of Forest Division Udhampur & Batote and Forest Protection Force Batote shall conduct special drive on regular basis (with concerned Police Authorities to keep a strict vigil on such type of activities in and around Patnitop area," it added.
SHO Police Station Kud and Police Station Batote shall provide necessary police assistance for implementation of the order, it stated and added that Tourist Police deployed at Patnitop shall monitor the campaign and take action against violators. Violators shall be booked under the provision of law & fine to the tune of Rs.1000 to Rs. 3000 shall be recovered from the violators into effect with immediate.

A case FIR No. 116/2022 under sections 13/18/39 UAPA, 4/5 Explosive substance Act has been registered at Doda police station, the ADGP said, adding investigation of the case is going on and more arrests and recoveries are expected at the disclosure by Irshad.
On June 4, police worked out a case related to low-intensity IED explosion outside a court complex in Udhampur district with the arrest of LeT terrorist Mohammad Ramzan Sohil of Ramban and his two associates, Khurshed Ahmad and Nisar Ahmad Khan of Doda, who were working at the behest of Khulbaib.
The blast in March had left one person dead and 14 others injured.
It is evident that Khulbaib is making desperate attempts to revive militancy in Chenab valley region (comprising Doda, Ramban and Kishtwar districts) by alluring local youths into militancy, and run terror modules for carrying out attacks in Jammu province, the ADGP said.

time," SSP, Doda, Abdul Qayoom told PTI.
Appealing to the people to maintain peace and law and order, he said one of the police teams has reached the site and found all the main idols at the temple intact.
Another police officer said an FIR has been registered at the Bhaderwah police station for a thorough probe.
He said additional deployment has been made in sensitive areas as a precautionary measure in view of the protests in parts of the district, including Bhaderwah and Ganderoh.
"There is some damage to the main door and an attempt was also made to break the donation box, while the robes of one of the deities was found on ground," the officer said, asking not to be named.
Shopkeepers observed a complete shutdown earlier in the day in response to a strike call given by Virendra Razdan, president of Shri Sanatan Dharam Sabha in Bhaderwah.
Razdan also led a protest to demand the identification of culprits and stern action against them.
On the assurance of Deputy Commissioner, Doda, Vikas Sharma and SSP Qayoom, the protesters at Bhadarwah who had blocked roads at several places including Domail, Sarol Bagh, Bhala, Seri Bazar, Gupt Ganga and Bhalra, suspended the stir after which shops opened and traffic started plying normally.
The residents of Bhaderwah who condemned the act said the "heinous crime is aimed at vitiating the otherwise peaceful atmosphere and communal harmony in the district."
Sajid Mir, Sarpanch Kursari Panchayat said, "We support the demand for a thorough probe to identify the culprits who have hurt the sentiments of a community and tried to trigger communal divide.
"They should be brought to book as we would not let anyone vitiate the peaceful atmosphere and communal harmony we are maintaining since ages,"
J&K president of Shri Sanatan Dharam Sabha, Purushottam Dadhichi also led a protest in Jammu against the incident and demanded action against the culprits.
"We have gathered here to protest the vandalism at the revered Vasuki Nag temple in Bhaderwah. This is the handiwork of mischievous elements who wanted to create a rift in the society," he said.

Senior Congress leader and former chief minister Ghulam Nabi Azad, who also hails from Bhaderwah town, strongly condemned the "mischievous act" of some "miscreant elements" and urged the local administration that the culprits should be brought to book immediately.
Azad also appealed to the people of Doda and Bhaderwah in particular to maintain peace and harmony and let the administration deal sternly with such elements who try to divide people and disturb peace and harmony in the region.
Jammu and Kashmir's Congress unit also expressed serious concern over the "mischievous act" done with a view to hurt religious sentiments and create hatred and trouble in the society.
"The government should identify the culprits and give them stern punishment," the

party said in a statement.
The party cautioned people to be aware of the designs of "enemies of peace" and maintain harmony.
Meanwhile, Former MLC and Trustee, J&K Dharmarth Trust, Vikramaditya Singh on Monday sought strict action against the rogue miscreant elements responsible for desecration and vandalisation of Vasuki Nag Maharaj Mandir, Kailash Kund in Bhadarwah.
Vikramaditya said that he had personally called up district officials concerned and already requested DC Doda and SSP Doda to investigate and probe the matter urgently besides punishing culprits as per law. Pertinent to mention that Vasuki Nag Mandir is located in Kailash Kund at an altitude of 13,500 ft.
