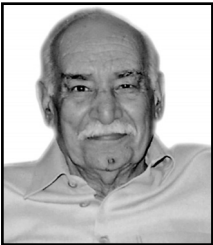

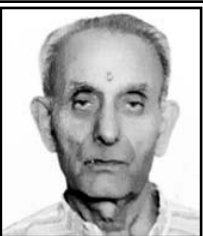

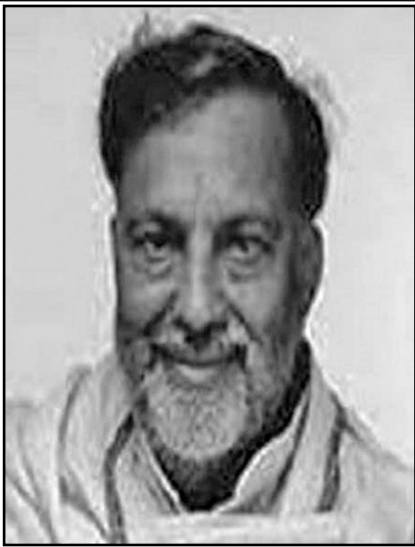

After qualifying LLM from University of London, Shri Bhim Singh joined Supreme Court of India as a Senior Advocate. He got married to Smt Jai Mala Devi and was blessed with a son, to whom he provided good education. He was very intelligent and honest advocate. Shri Bhim Singh was a social and polite person, always ready to help poor & needy. He breathed his last on May 31, 2022 due to illness. He was an Indian politician, social activist, lawyer and author. He was Founder President and Chief Patron of J&K National Panthers Party. He was an elected member of J&K Legislative Assembly from 1977 until 1987 from Chenani (Udhampur) constituency. He had gone on a hunger strike along with former Prime Minister Atal Behari Vajpayee against Election Commission of India's decision. He is survived by wife and a son.

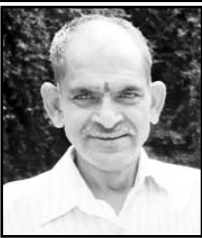

CRIME REPORT

28 bovines rescued, smuggler rescued

RAMBAN: Police on Tuesday rescued 28 bovines at Navyuga Tunnel and arrested a smuggler.

As per the details, acting on the specific inputs regarding the transportation of the bovines to the valley, a party of Police Post Jawahar Tunnel intercepted one Truck (JK03D-7802) driven by a person namely Juguan Shah, son of Mohd Iqbal Shah, resident of Sherbibi, Chamalwas, Banihal loaded with 28 bovines, all the rescued bovines were found loaded with utmost cruelty and without any arrangements of food and water. These bovines were being transported to the valley without permission of competent authority. On this a case, FIR No 134/2022 under section 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act was registered and investigation set into motion.

The overall rescue operation was made by the police team under the supervision of PSI Harish Kumar, In-Charge Police Post Jawahar Tunnel, Insp Muneer Khan SHO Banihal, Nissar Ahmed Khoja SDPO Banihal and under the overall Supervision of Mohita Sharma, SP Ramban.

Illegal crusher, hot mix plant sealed in Rajouri

RAJOURI: District Administration Rajouri has launched a major crackdown to curb illegal mining practices in Rajouri and violators are being dealt strictly as per the mining norms.

In this connection, an enforcement team conducted a raid at Gambir area and sealed an illegal crusher unit and one hot Mix Plant there.

The whole operation was carried out under the supervision of the Deputy Commissioner, Vikas Kundal and District Mineral Officer, Mohammad Naseeb Bajran. The District Mineral Officer said that the District Administration has been taking strict measures to ensure that the mining was done legally and the perpetrators of illegal mining practices were dealt with firmly. He informed that a number of complaints were being received in the Office about the said crusher and hot mix plant. "Major crackdown has been launched against illegal mining and special raids are also being conducted on a regular basis to curb such practices in the district", he added.

The DMO has also appealed to the public to immediately bring in notice of the administration if they find any person indulging in illegal mining so that appropriate action could be taken against the perpetrators.

8 vehicles involved in illegal mining seized

RAJOURI: Acting against illegal mining practice in river bed, Jammu and Kashmir police in Nowshera sub division of Rajouri seized three different vehicles being used for this unlawful practice.

Police said that a team headed by SHO Nowshera Rajesh Jasrotia acted on the specific inputs and raided at specific location and intercepted three different vehicles involved in illegal mining.

Later, these vehicles were handed over to DMO Rajouri for further legal necessary course of action.

The seized vehicles include one Poelain JCB bearing Chasis No PUNJD20BLJ224107, one dumper bearing registration number JK11B 0778 and another dumper with registration number JK11B-5296.

Pertinent to mention here that in order to strictly implement the drive against illegal mining and to tighten noose against the violators of the law, Rajouri Police has initiated strict action and seized a number of vehicles involved in illegal mining practice.

At Handwara, acting tough against the elements involved in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals, Police on Tuesday seized a vehicle in Handwara.

As per the details, a party of Police Station Qalamabad alongwith officials from Geology and Mining Department have seized a vehicle (tipper) for their involvement in illegal extraction and transportation of minerals from Govt land at Qalamabad.

Accordingly, legal action under the provisions of MMDR (Mines & Minerals Development and Regulation) Act has been registered in this regard and investigation has been initiated.

Meanwhile, police teams of Police Posts Pouni Chak and Phallain. Mandal acted stringently on the specific inputs and raided at different locations in their respective areas and seized 04 different vehicles involved in illegal mining. The seized vehicles include 3 tractor trollies without Registration Nos seized by Pounichak police and 1 tractor trolley (JK02CK-3169) by Phallain Mandal police. The recoveries were made In-Charge Police Posts Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria and Phallain Mandal PSI Ajesh Singh Jamwal in their respective jurisdictions.

Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin

JAMMU: Continuing it's drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Tuesday arrested a narco smuggler at Marble market chowk and recovered 20 grams of heroin from his possession.

As per the details, a team of Police Station Bahu Fort led by SHO Bahu Fort Insp. Nayat Ali while on Naka duty rounded up one suspect in a vehicle (HP37F-8174) when he was on his way from marble market towards Baghed Mandi. On search 20 grams of heroin was recovered from him. The suspect identified as Manpreet Singh, son of Palwinder Singh, resident of Ambhika colony Gangwal was arrested and FIR No 156/2022 under section 8/21/22/ NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Bahu Fort. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari.

Two missing persons traced, reunited with families

JAMMU: Police on Tuesday traced two missing persons and reunited them with their families.

As per the details, a complaint was lodged at Police Post Pounichak, by the legal heirs of the woman , stating that she got missing from her respective home. In this regard a missing report was registered and investigation started. On this, a police team was formed under the supervision of SDPO Domana Sunil Singh led by SHO Domana Insp. Tilak Raj assisted by In-Charge Police Post Pounichak PSI Nitish Khajuria which did hectic efforts and traced out the missing woman.

Similarly another complaint was lodged at Police Station Bakshi Nagar by legal heirs of a boy namely Rohit Sawhney, son of Ashok Kumar, resident of Mazdoor Basti, Resham Ghar, Jammu. In this regard a missing report was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Bakshi Nagar under the

supervision of SDPO West Rahul Nagar led by SHO Bakshi Nagar Inspr Harjeet Singh did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally traced the missing boy.

Subsequently family of the missing persons were informed and the traced persons were handed over to their family members after completing all the legal formalities.

Two injured in separate mishaps

2 drug peddlers arrested; contraband substance recovered

SRINAGAR: Police in its recent action against drug dealings in Baramulla & Handwara on Tuesday arrested two drug peddlers and recovered contraband substance from their possession.

In Baramulla, a party of Police Station Tangmarg under the supervision of SDPO Tangmarg Hilal Khaliq at a checkpoint established at Drung Crossing intercepted a person identified as Tahir Bashir Khan son of Bashir Ahmad Khan resident of Cheek Perozpura Tangmarg. During search, officers were able to recover 109 grams of Charas from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains custody.

Similarly in Handwara, a police party of PS Handwara arrested a lady drug peddler and recovered 25 grams of Brown Sugar and cash amount of Rs 1,04,300, believed to be proceed of drug sale, from her possession.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective Police Stations and investigation have been initiated.
