Similarly, a police party led by Incharge Police Post Kungamdora arrested one drug smuggler identified as Khalid Rashid Lone son of Abdul Rashid Lone resident of Hanjiwera Pattan during naka checking at Kungamdora Pattan. During search, 50 grams of charas like substance was recovered from his possession.

In Kulgam, a police party headed by SHO Police Station Behibah at a checkpoint established at Kadder intercepted a suspicious person identified as Mushtaq Ahmad Thoker son of Mohd Hayat Thoker resident of Kadder. During checking, 2.3Kgs of Cannabis Powder and 50 grams of Charas carrying in a Nylon bag was recovered from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered at respective police stations and investigation has been initiated.

Meanwhile, a police party led by SHO Police Station Uri during Naka checking at Saidpora Uri intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully. During search, 80 grams of Heroin like substance was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Mehmood Shah son of Ghulam Nabi Shah resident of Nambla Uri. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

## 3,200 Metric Ton illegally extracted sand seized

KISHTWAR: A joint team of Officers of different enforcement departments today carried out a successful operation against the illegal mining here under the supervision of Deputy Commissioner, Dr Devansh Yadav.

The team comprising District Mineral Officer, Dr. Brijesh Manhas, Tehsildar Satish Rana and S.I Amrinder Singh seized a whopping 3200 metric ton illegally extracted sand found dumped on the roadside in Tehsil Atholi of the Paddar Sub division of District Kishtwar.

To curb the rampant illegal extraction of minor minerals and safeguard the environment, the enforcement authorities have launched a major crackdown in the District. Upon inspection, it was established that the perpetrators had violated the law, prompting the Enforcement team to take decisive action.

As a consequence, the offenders have been directed to present themselves at the District Mineral Office on Monday, 5th June 2023, for the compounding of the offense.

The DMO Kishtwar has issued a stern warning to all potential wrongdoers, making it abundantly clear that any future involvement in illegal extraction activities will not be tolerated.

Meanwhile, the district administration has stepped up surveillance in the areas prone to illegal mining and transportation of construction material.

The mule track leading from the Main road to the riverbanks of Chenab at Navnatnoo area in Tehsil Nagseni has been identified as a potential site for illegal activities. The District Administration is actively monitoring the situation and has taken necessary measures to ensure strict adherence to the law.

The enforcement actions carried out by the district administration exemplify its commitment towards maintaining ecological balance in the district.

**Srdrn Tirath Kour** daughter of late S. Dhian Singh and late Srdrn Radha was born in 1930 in village Dholi, Tehsil Bagh (Now in POJK). She had three brothers and three sisters. During 1947 holocaust she received a bullet in her neck and fell unconscious while her two brothers and a sister were killed in Pak firing. Taking her as dead in a pond of blood, her mother paid her homage by spreading upon her a Dupatta and rushed to join the group of people rushing for a refuge. After some time, Srdrn Tirath Kour came to senses and anyhow reached Poonch hospital on 3rd day with worms in the wound. She recovered after some days and joined her mother. She got married to S. Gurbachan Singh an INA soldier. She was blessed with a son and three daughters.

Her husband was killed in Pak shelling in 1971 War due to which she again had to pass through a dark spell of life. She continued struggling and provided good education to her children who are now well settled. She was a very gentle, polite, hospitable and hardworking lady who after facing extreme hardships and even the death warrants, defeated the misfortune and created a niche in the society.

She breathed her last on 27th May, 2023 due to failure of multi organs. She is survived by her son, daughters and grand children.

# CRIME REPORT

## Narco-smuggler held with heroin

UDHAMPUR: Police on Wednesday recovered 5.40 gms of contraband substance (Chitta) from one narcotic smuggler at Roun Domail, Udhampur.

As per details, a party of Police Post Roundmail led by Insp. Raghubir Singh SHO Udhampur and assisted by PSI Rhythm Sharma In-Charge Police Post Roundmail while routine Naka checking at Roundmail apprehended one suspected person who tried to escape from the police party. However the said person was taken into custody and during his personal search, 5.40 grams of contraband substance (Chitta) was recovery from his possession. The accused identified as Imran Ahmed, son of Nazir Ahmed, resident of Chak Hartayan, Udhampur, was arrested and FIR No. 299/2023 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him in Police Station Udhampur.
