JAMMU: National Democratic Party Indian (NDPI) J&K UT Chief Rajesh Gupta on Wednesday strongly condemned the target killing in South Kashmir and expressed his heartfelt condolences to the members of bereaved family. Gupta questions why govt has soft corner for Kashmiri

Pandits? He demanded an ex-gratia amount of Rs 1 crore and a Govt job for kith and kins of target killing victim Deepu who hails from Udhampur District of Jammu and Kashmir UT.

Deepu, who was shot dead by terrorists in Anantnag district of South Kashmir on Monday evening, was the sole breadwinner in his family, said Gupta.

He further said, Deepu, who was working in a circus, is survived by his father - who is visually impaired - and his sibling who too has had eyesight issues for the last four years.

NDPI leader said earlier also target killing happened in Kashmir Valley and most of Kashmiri Pandits were killed and LG Manoj Sinha

himself visited to the homes of victim's family and gave them appointment letter and an ex- gratia relief cheque of Rs 1 crore to each victim. Now why the discrimination with Jammu man.

We are not against the Kashmiri Pandits but we Jammuites will not tolerate injustice with Deepu.

Court awards 10 years RI, Rs 1 lakh fine to two narco smugglers

JAMMU: Principal Sessions Judge Udhampur Haq Nawaz Zargar today awarded 10 years rigorous imprisonment and fine Rs 1 lac to two narco smugglers namely Gowhar Ahmed Khanday and Abdul Qayoom Khanday from whom charas was recovered.

According to the police case that The accused persons above-named have been facing trial for offences punishable under section 8/20/29 of NDPS Act having been caught red handed while transporting Charas in the shape of balls in commercial quantity. The weight of one bag containing 96 balls was 6.565 Kgs (including poly-thene bags) and the weight of other bag containing 76 balls was 6.040 Kgs (including polythene bags). Both the polythene bags carrying charas balls were kept inside the layers of a quilt in the dickey of the vehicle Tata Indigo

Court awards 10 years RI, and Rs 25,000 fine in rape with minor

JAMMU: 2nd Additional Sessions Judge Srinagar Renu Dogra today awarded 10 years rigorous imprisonment and fine Rs 25,000 to Irshad Ahmad Malik S/O Habib-ullah Malik R/o Ahlan Gadwak Kokernag Anantnag at present Anchar Soura for rape with minor.

The prosecution case as culminated in the form of present charge-sheet is that on 18th of May 2012 complainant lodged a written report with the police of Police Station Soura to the effect that he is a labour by profession and used to go out of his house daily in the early morning for work and return back in the evening. At his home there lives his daughter (name with held) and his wife. In his neighbourhood one person namely Irshad Ahmad Malik S/o Habibi-ullah Malik lives in the house of one Ghulam Qadir Wani S/o

Mohammed Wani R/o Sheikh Mohallah Soura as a tenant. His minor daughter used to go to his residence (Dara). Some days before, his daughter complained of pain in abdomen as such he took his daughter (Victim) to doctor for treatment where the doctor conducted some important tests of the girl and doctors certified that victim girl was having a child in her womb. He and his wife enquired from their daughter who disclosed that the person who resides in their neighbourhood resident of Rajouri namely Irshad Ahmad has several times raped her .

After receiving the report, police registered the case under FIR No 33/2012 for the commission of offence punishable under Section 376 RPC in police Station Soura.

2nd Additional Sessions Judge Srinagar Renu Dogra after hearing both

bearing registration No. MH02AY-8677 travelling from Srinagar towards Jammu. According to the prosecution, the above said vehicle was stopped for routine checking on 08.01.2019 by the police team headed by SI Vishal Dogra at Jakheni Chowk. The vehicle was being driven by A-1 Gowhar Ahmed Khanday whereas the other A-2 was a co-driver/passenger and upon checking two bags filled with charas were found loaded thereon where-after SI Vishal Dogra immediately sent a docket to the Incharge P/S Udhampur leading to the registration of FIR No. 12/2019 for offence under section 8/20/29 NDPS Act. The investigation was entrusted to SI Vishav Pratap Singh, who swung into action and reached on spot immediately. The Investigating Officer took the weight of two bags and drew samples of 50 grams each duplicates on spot in

presence of witnesses and accused. The samples were forwarded to FSL for chemical analysis and expert opinion and the report received there from eventually confirmed the contents of charas.

Principal Sessions Judge Udhampur Haq Nawaz Zargar after hearing Public Prosecutor Koshal Kotwal appearing for the Police observed that offence of which accused have been held guilty is heinous and encompasses the society as a whole under its sweep particularly the youngsters and other vulnerable sections of the society. Thus, showing any leniency to the guilty convicts will amount to doing cruelty to the innocent public/ persons including children who will likely to be affected by this menace. In the circumstances, the convict namely Gowhar Ahmed Khanday S/o Mohd Ramzan Khanday R/o Mast Pora,

Tehsil Killer, District Shopian is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for Ten years and to pay a fine of Rs. 1.00 lakh for commission of offence under sections 8/20/29 NDPS Act. In case of failure of convict to pay the fine, he shall further undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year. The period of imprisonment already undergone by the convict during investigation /trial shall be set off from the period of sentence. Furthermore, the convict namely Abdul Qayoom Khanday S/o Wali Mohd Khanday R/o Mir Mohalla, Killer, District Shopian is sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for Ten years and to pay a fine of Rs. 1.00 lakh for commission of offence under sections 8/20/29 NDPS Act. In case of failure of convict to pay the fine, he shall further undergo rigorous imprisonment for one year.

Court grants 15 days police remand in trap case

JAMMU: Additional Sessions Judge Anticorruption Rajouri Mehmood Ahmed Choudhary today granted 15 days police remand of I/c Block forest Officer, Thakrakote, Reasi and Forest Guard who were caught-red handed by ACB while accepting bribe Rs 15,000/-.

According to the case that Anti Corruption Bureau received a complaint against Abneet Kumar presently posted at Beat Bharakh with additional charge of Beat Narla Bambal. In the complaint, the complainant alleged that he had taken one dry fallen Chir tree from the forest and after few days Munshi of PP Taryath contacted the complainant and told that Forest Guard namely Abneet Kumar of beat Narla Bambal lodged a complaint against him for cutting/taking of tree from the forest without permission. When the complainant met Munshi of PP Teryath, he told him to settle the matter with the Forest Guard. When the complainant contacted forest guard through another persons,

he demanded Rs 22,000 as bribe for withdrawal of application and settlement. On this the complainant approached ACB and lodged complaint in Police Station ACB Rajouri for taking legal action against the above named Forest Guard.

Since the contents of the complaint disclose demand of bribe by alleged accused public servant the same was verified through verifying officer who reported that prima facie commission of offences under section 7 of PC Act 1988 is made out against the accused Abneet Kumar Forest Guard. Accordingly, case FIR No. 02/2023 of PS ACB Rajouri and investigation started.

During investigation a trap team was constituted. However, during the trap proceedings, another forest official Sat Pal, I/c Block officer Thakrakote was also found involved in the conspiracy with the said Forest Guard Abneet Kumar. They were caught red-handed while demanding and accepting bribe of Rs 15,000 from the complainant. Both of them were arrested on spot after completing necessary legal formalities.
