

Udhampur among country's most developed constituencies in 9 years: Dr Jitendra

UDHAMPUR: Union Minister, Dr Jitendra Singh on Monday said, Udhampur-Kathua-Doda is among the country's most developed Lok Sabha constituencies in the last 9 years. This has been possible because Prime Minister Narendra Modi was forthcoming in giving high priority to the regions that had been neglected by the earlier governments, he said.

The Minister was addressing a public rally here to mark the completion of 9 years of the government headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. Dr Jitendra said, Udhampur got North India's first river rejuvenation project in the form of Rs 190 cr Devika project. He said, the question to ask is why no earlier government or MP took it up even though river Devika has been there for centuries and has been worshipped by all as the elder sister of Ganga. Udhampur also got its first Radio Station for which the demand had

existed for over half a century, he said.

Dr. Jitendra said, Udhampur-Kathua-Doda Parliamentary Constituency is perhaps the only Constituency in India which got three medical Colleges from central funds in these 9 years.

Dr. Singh said, this constituency has distinguished its name in India and in the world as the birthplace of 'Purple Revolution' which has given birth to Agri-tech Start-Ups and lavender farming not only in J&K but across the country.

This Parliamentary

Constituency has all the potential to contribute to the Start-Up movement promoted by PM Narendra Modi, Dr. Jitendra said. He recalled that only recently PM Modi had referred twice to Bhaderwah's lavender cultivation, first in Mann Ki Baat and later in a tweet.

Enumerating various infrastructural developments that have taken place from the last many years in this constituency, Dr. Jitendra said, the highest railway bridge in the world, higher than the Eiffel tower and Dr. Shyama Prasad

Mookherjee tunnel, the longest road tunnel in Asia are both located in this constituency making it an infrastructural marvel in the country.

In terms of road and highway development in this constituency, Dr. Jitendra Singh said, the Vande Bharat Express from Katra to Delhi, the North India's first ever Cable-Stayed Bridge Atal Setu, J&K's first inter-State bridge at Keerian-Gandiyal, North India's first Express Road Corridor from Delhi to Katra via Kathua, the new National Highway from Lakhampur-Basohli-Doda via Chattargala

Tunnel have made this constituency best ever connected leading to its tremendous development compared to the other con-

stituencies. Udhampur district located in this constituency has stood number one in the country in terms of construction of roads under PMGSY, Dr. Jitendra added.

Dr. Jitendra said, with the establishment of an Inter Modal Station (IMS) at Katra, a world class state of the art project in this constituency will not only improve the travelling experience of the pilgrims visiting Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine but will open numerous opportunities in terms of employment, trade etc. for the people of this constituency.

With half a dozen power projects in different stages of construction, Kishitwar is all set to emerge as North India's "power hub", the Minister said.

Further, Dr Jitendra Singh said, India's first of its kind National Institute of High Altitude Medicine has come up in Bhaderwah.

The constituency got two Passport offices in Kathua and Udhampur respectively, he said.

A statue of Maharaja Gulab Singh, founder Dogra ruler, has been put up at the entry point at Lakhampur while Patnitop got a Gandola in last few years, said Dr Jitendra.

DC Jammu reviews arrangements for Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra 2023

JAMMU: Deputy Commissioner Jammu, Avny Lavasa on Monday convened a meeting to review the arrangements for smooth conduct of Shri Amarnath Ji Yatra 2023 here in DC Office complex.

SSP Chandan Kohli; Commissioner JMC, Rahul Yadav; ADC, ADM Sandeep Seoindra; RTO, CMO SDMS, along with senior officers from Jal Shakti, JPDCL, Tourism, Information & PR, Security, Health, CRPF and representatives from various religious organizations and other stakeholders were present in the meeting.

At the outset, the Deputy Commissioner took a detailed review regarding arrangements of all the facilities including accommodation, barricading, security arrangements, installation of technical equipment and wi-fi, Public Address System, the provision of power and water supply cleanliness, sanitation and medical facilities at registration counters, Lodgement centres and

especially in the Jammu Base Camp- Yatri Niwas.

It was informed to the Chair that in all five counters that have been established for Taktal registration of the pilgrims at Vaishnavi Dham, Mahajan Sabha, Panchayat Ghar and two at Geeta Bhawan and Ram Mandir for the registration of Sadhus.

It was also apprised that a token counter has also been established at Saraswati Dham for the disbursement of pilgrims and crowd management.

The meeting was further informed that the pilgrims can get their RIFD cards from counters at Vaishnavi Dham and Railway Station.

Regarding cleanliness, sanitation, lights and mobile toilet facilities at Yatri Niwas, lodgement centres, registration counters etc, the Municipal Commissioner, Jammu assured that needful will be done as per the past practice.

The DC directed the senior officers of police department to ensure that every langar should be equipped with CCTV and proper

lighting system. She also asked them to ensure proper barricading and deployment of security personnel at checkpoints.

Regarding health-care, the DC asked the CMO to depute adequate teams of doctors along with para medical staff and ambulances at yatri niwas and other required sites, who will perform their duties round the clock for the convenience of the pilgrims.

The Deputy Commissioner directed all the officers present in the meeting to ensure that all necessary arrangements for smooth conduct of Yatra to be carried out by their respective department are put in place well in time before the commencement of Yatra.

She also directed the concerned officers to gear up their men and machinery to ensure adequate arrangements for the comfortable journey and stay of Yatri. She asked the concerned departments to make sure that the pilgrims do not face any hardship on account of basic amenities.


President Kailash Jyotish & Vedic Sansthan Trust calls on LG
