

The special investigation team has been constituted to ensure that no perpe trator, aider, abettor or conspirator of crime goes scot free and exemplary, lacunae-free investigation is conducted to bring to the fore the facts.

Three days back, on the intervening night of 11th and 12th of June at 12:45 a.m., Samba Police had achieved a major success by arresting three (3) dreaded heroin smugglers of Punjab who had opened fire upon local youth a Rangoor Camp, Ramgarh. 2.080 K.G. heroin worth rupees 14 Cr approxi mately,1 pistol, 1 magazine, ammunition and rupees 93200.00 Indian currency, 4 costly mobile phones, Innova vehicle used for smuggling and looted bike were recovered by Samba Police. Investigation of case FIR No. 31/2023 under sections 307/392 IPC, 3/25 Arms Act, 8 /21/22/25/27-A/29 NDPS Act is being conducted by SIT headed by SP rank officer and comprising of three gazetted Police Officers and two Inspectors under the supervision of SSP Samba so that entire smugglers' module is busted and conviction is secured at

5 drug peddlers arrested; contraband recovered STATE TIMES NEWS

KULGAM/ BARAMULLA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Thursday arrested 5 drug peddlers in Kulgam & Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from their posses-

In Kulgam, a police party headed by In-charge Police Post Navyug Tunnel Qazigund during its routine patrolling near Navyug Tunnel Qazigund intercepted a suspicious vehicle (Santro) bearing registration No. CH03R-3855 with 04 persons onboard. During search of the vehicle, 830 grams of Charas like contraband substance was recovered

They have been identified as Sher Aalam Khan son of Nawab Khan & Sohail Ahmad Khan son of Shahzad Ahmad Khan, both residents of Dadoo Marhama, Anantnag, Ashraf Ali son of Noor Mohammad resident of Dandal Udhampur and Makhan Lal son of Hans Raj resident of Ossu Udhampur. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in

custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime was also seized. In Baramulla, acting on a specific information that one person namely Zubair ul Islam son of Ghulam Mohiuddin Dar resident of Tantraypora Palhallan Pattan has hoarded narcotic substance at his residential house Accordingly, a police party of Police Post Palhallan under the supervision of SDPO Pattan along with concerned Magistrate raided the specific location.

During search of the house, 9.2 Kgs of Grinded Poppy Straw like contraband substance was recovered and seized. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Regarding the incidents, cases under relevant sections of law have been reg-

istered in respective police stations and investigations have been initiated. Multiple bovine smuggling bids foiled, 47 animals rescued

their clutches.

RAJOURI: As many as 47 bovines have been rescued with five vehicles have been seized and nine cases registered by police in Rajouri while foiling multiple bovine smuggling bids in last two days.
