School teacher arrested for 'molesting' 2 students

SRINAGAR: A teacher of a private school here has been arrested for allegedly sexually assaulting two girl students, officials said on Thursday.

Satar Beigh (42), a resident of the Gurez area of north Kashmir's Bandipora district and currently staying at Hyderpora here, was arrested on Wednesday, they said.

Beigh, who teaches Arabic in the Holy Faith school at Rawalpura, was arrested for allegedly molesting and sexually assaulting two students of Classes 4 and 5 in the school, the officials said.

A case under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act has been registered, they said.

Narco smuggler nabbed with heroin

BISHNAH: Police on Thursday nabbed a narco smuggler and recovered 5 Gms heroin from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Bishnah during Naka at Mehmoodpur found one pedestrian on the way towards Naka point. Police party signalled to stop said pedestrian but he tried to escape from the said Naka point. On this, police overpowered him and during preliminary enquiry, he disclosed his name as Nipun Saini, son of BS Saini, resident of Greater Kailash Jammu. During personal search 5 gms of heroin like substance recovered from his possession.

He was arrested and FIR No 151/23 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bishnah.



Two nabbed with opium, poppy straw

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Thursday nabbed two drug peddlers and recovered 150 grams of opium and 80 grams of poppy straw from them.

As per details, a team of Police Station Satwari led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Satwari Inspr Sumeet Sharma and In-Charge Police Post Belicharana SI



Sugreev Kumar while on Naka duty at Fourth Bridge Belicharana rounded up two suspected persons on a Truck (JK02CC-7043). During search, 150 grams of opium and 80 grams of poppy straw was recovered from the accused.

Accused identified as Sohan Singh, son of Janak Singh, resident of Malpur Kot Balwal Jammu and Manpreet Singh, son of Jagjeet Singh, resident of Talab Tillo Jammu were arrested and FIR No.115/2023 under sections 8/15/17 NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Satwari.

Drug peddler arrested; 3 Kgs Ganja recovered

Missing girl traced, reunited with family

RS PURA: Police on Thursday traced a missing girl and reunited her with her family.

As per details, a complaint was lodged at Police Station R S Pura by the legal heirs of a girl stating that she got missing from her home.

In this regard missing report on May 23, 2023 was registered and investigation got started.

On this, a team of Police Station RS Pura led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO RS Pura Inspr Pawan Kumar and In-Charge Border Police Post Chakroi PSI Ishfaq Ahmed kasana with the help of technical assistance generated the input regarding the missing girl in Chandigarh. On this Police teams were deputed to Chandigarh and finally traced out the missing girl from Chandigarh with the help of local police of the concerned area.

Subsequently family of the missing girl was informed and she was handed over to the family members after completing all the medico-legal formalities.

SIT constituted to investigate heroin smuggling & firing case

SAMBA: Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Samba, Benam Tosh has constituted a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to investigate heroin smuggling & firing case of border village Rangoor Camp in which 3 hardcore heroin smugglers of Punjab were arrested by Police and heroin valuing rupees 14 crores approx., pistol, ammunition, Rs 93200.00 cash, mobiles were recovered by Police three days ago.

Additional SP Samba Surinder Choudhary has been designated as Incharge SIT, whereas SDPO Vijaypur, DySP Operations Samba, SHO Police Station Rangarh and Inspector Sham Lal of Police Station Rangarh have been appointed as members of the SIT.

The Special Investigation Team (SIT) shall be conducting investigation in consul-



tation with learned Prosecuting Officers under the direct supervision of SSP Samba.

The special investigation team has been constituted to ensure that no perpetrator, aider, abettor or conspirator of crime goes scot free and exemplary, lacunae-free investigation is conducted to bring to the fore the facts.

Three days back, on the intervening night of 11th and 12th of June at 12:45 a.m., Samba Police had achieved a major success by arresting three (3) dreaded heroin smugglers of Punjab who had opened fire upon local youth at Rangoor Camp, Rangarh. 2.080 K.G. heroin worth rupees 14 Cr approximately, 1 pistol, 1 magazine, ammunition and rupees 93200.00 Indian currency, 4 costly mobile phones, Innova vehicle used for smuggling and looted bike were recovered by Samba Police. Investigation of case FIR No. 31/2023 under sections 307/392 IPC, 3/25 Arms Act, 8 /21/22/25/27-A/29 NDPS Act is being conducted by SIT headed by SP rank officer and comprising of three gazetted Police Officers and two Inspectors under the supervision of SSP Samba so that entire smugglers' module is busted and conviction is secured at the court of law.

5 drug peddlers arrested; contraband recovered

KULGAM/ BARAMULLA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Thursday arrested 5 drug peddlers in Kulgam & Baramulla and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

In Kulgam, a police party headed by In-charge Police Post Navyug Tunnel Qazigund during its routine patrolling near Navyug Tunnel Qazigund intercepted a suspicious vehicle (Santro) bearing registration No. CH03R-3855 with 04 persons onboard. During search of the vehicle, 830 grams of Charas like contraband substance was recovered.

They have been identified as Sher Aalam Khan son of Nawab Khan & Sohail Ahmad Khan son of Shahzad Ahmad Khan, both residents of Dadoo Marhama, Anantnag, Ashraf Ali son of Noor Mohammad resident of Dandal Udhampur and Makhana Lal son of Hans Raj resident of Ossu Udhampur. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime was also seized.

In Baramulla, acting on a specific information that one person namely Zubair ul Islam son of Ghulam Mohiuddin Dar resident of Tantraypora Palhallan Pattan has hoarded narcotic substance at his residential house. Accordingly, a police party of Police Post Palhallan under the supervision of SDPO Pattan along with concerned Magistrate raided the specific location.

During search of the house, 9.2 Kgs of Grinded Poppy Straw like contraband substance was recovered and seized. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Regarding the incidents, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and investigations have been initiated.

Multiple bovine smuggling bids foiled, 47 animals rescued

RAJOURI : As many as 47 bovines have been rescued with five vehicles have been seized and nine cases registered by police in Rajouri while foiling multiple bovine smuggling bids in last two days.

These bids have been foiled by teams of Rajouri police station headed under the supervision of SHO Rajouri Mohammad Shovket Choudhary.

Police in its official statement said that nine bovine smuggling bids have been foiled across Rajouri police station areas in last two days with five vehicles have been seized as these were being used for smuggling of bovines.

Three of these bids have been foiled on area of Police Post Chingus while other six in area of Rajouri police station.

Nine cases in relevant sections of law have been registered while many bovine smugglers have been arrested with forty seven bovines have been rescued from their clutches.
