REASI: Department of Social Welfare Reasi, in collaboration with Police Department, organised an interactive session cum awareness program on Mental Health and Drug Abuse for the students of Government Polytechnic College Reasi on Thursday. Additional District Development Commissioner, Reasi, Jyoti Salathia was the Chief Guest. The ADCC, while interacting with students, reflected that youth are extremely susceptible to drugs and underlined the need to keep a close vigil on their activities.. "Drugs deteriorate mental health and peer pressure leads

vulnerable teenagers to indulge in drug abuse and become addicts. Drugs destroy lives, since the addicts can see nothing beyond their need to take drugs. We must urgently deal with the problem of drug abuse," she said. DySP HQ, while interacting with the students, informed them about the special helpline 9070907017 and urged them to join hands in the fight against drug abuse. The District Social Welfare Officer Reasi also interacted with the students and faculty. He conducted activities with students on the need of "COMMUNICATION & PARTICIPATION". SHO Reasi, in his lecture,
