



CRIME REPORT

2 drug peddlers arrested, contraband recovered

BUDGAM/ KULGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police on Friday arrested 2 drug peddlers in Budgam and Kulgam and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Khansahib at a checkpoint established at Yarikhah near Kralpathri crossing intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot after noticing the police party but was apprehended tactfully. During search, 50 grams of Charas like substance and 1.8 Kgs of Bhang Patri was recovered from his possession. He has been identified as Ghulam Hassan Sheikh alias Hassan Lali son of Abdul Gani Sheikh resident of Yarikhah Khansahib. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 70/2023 under relevant sections of law has been registered at Police Station Khansahib and investigation has been taken up.

Meanwhile, a party headed by SHO Police Station Qazigund at a checkpoint established at Levloora Crossing intercepted a vehicle (Bus) bearing registration No. JK02BM-4755 with 02 persons onboard. During search of the vehicle, 10 Kgs of Poppy Straw like contraband substance filled in the nylon bag which was kept behind the driver's seat was recovered. They have been identified as Rakesh Kumar (Driver) son of Ball Krishan a resident of Khadi Udhampur and Samraj son of Bansilal a resident of Dhar road Jammu. They have been arrested and shifted to police station where they remain in custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime was also seized.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 116/2023 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Qazigund and investigation has been initiated.

Notorious drug peddler arrested, Chitta recovered

SAMBA: Under the guidance of SSP Samba Benam Tosh, Police has arrested a notorious drug peddler and recovered heroin ('Chitta') worth rupees 15,000.00 approximately from his possession.

The arrested drug peddler has been identified as Aman Kumar Sharma, son of Pawan Kumar Sharma, resident of Katra. FIR No. 139/2023 under sections 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bari Brahmana.

Accused Aman used to collect heroine ('chitta') from Bari Brahmana area and he has been nabbed by police when he was coming out of infamous hotspot after collecting heroin, as police has intensified patrolling to apprehend heroine suppliers operating in the heroine-infested areas of Samba District.

The drug peddler has been arrested by police team comprising of SHO Police Station Bari Brahmana Sunil Sharma and PSI Rajat Sharma.

DMO Samba takes tough action against illegal mining, seizes two dumpers

3 arrested, 3 vehicles seized for Illegal extraction and transportation of minerals

Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Pattan and further investigation has been initiated.

2 smugglers arrested, 21 Kg poppy straw recovered

UDHAMPUR: Continuing its campaign against Drugs and Narcotics, Udhampur Police arrested two smugglers and recovered 21 kg of Poppy Straw at Jakhani checking point (NHW).

As per details, a team of Police Station Udhampur headed by Insp. Raghuraj Singh while conducting routine vehicle checking at Jakhani naka point NH, stopped a maruti SX4 (HR07E-0900) which was coming from Kashmir valley towards Udhampur for checking purpose.

During checking of said vehicle, Police recovered 21 kg of poppy straw (alongwith weight of packing material) and arrested two accused persons who were smuggling the above poppy straw in the said vehicle which was also seized.

The arrested persons disclosed their identities as Mohd. Amin Ganie, son of Mohd. Akbar Ganie, resident of Anantnag and Tariq Ahmed Mir, son of Ghulam Hassan Mir, resident of Anantnag. FIR No. 326/2023 under relevant sections of law was registered against them at Police Station Udhampur.

Bootlegger nabbed, 28 bottles of liquor recovered

Two narco smugglers nabbed with heroin, cash

RAMBAN: Police on Friday foiled a narcotics smuggling bid at Banihal by arresting two persons with heroin like substance.

As per details, while on routine Naka checking duty, police party of T-Chowk Naka Banihal intercepted two pedestrians who were coming by foot from railway station road to Banihal market side. During checking, 10 gms of heroin like substance, Rs 10, 000 and two syringes along with foil from their possession was recovered from their possession.

On enquiry, they disclosed their identity as Saqib Nazir, son of Nazir Ahmed, resident of Mahwat Changloo and Muzaffar Ahmed, son of Habib ullah Wagay, resident of Karawah Banihal, at present Gujjar Nagar Jammu. The said accused persons were arrested and FIR No. 142/2023 under sections 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act was registered against them at Police Station Banihal. The arrest and recovery was made by the party of Police Station Banihal under the command of PSI Ishan Sharma I/C SHO Banihal.

787 bovines rescued under operation 'Kamdhenu'

RAMBAN: During the past few days, acting on the specific inputs of transportation of bovine animals, different parties of Police Stations Batote, Chanderkote, Ramban, Banihal, Dharamkund, and Gool intercepted some vehicles and some persons taking bovines by foot and were on their way from Jammu towards Srinagar, and after checking of the vehicles, it was found that 787 bovines were loaded in the vehicles with utmost cruelty and without any arrangements of food and water and these bovine animals were being transported to the valley without any valid permission of competent authority and otherwise, thereby rescuing in total 787 bovine animals under the operation "Kamdhenu".

In this regard, 17 FIRs in Police Station Batote, 13 FIRs in Chanderkote, 10 FIRs in Ramban, 14 FIRs in Banihal, 1 FIRs in Dharamkund and 2 FIRs in Gool under Sections 188 IPC, 11 PC Act stands registered and investigation set into motion.

The overall rescue operation was made by police parties under the command of Insp Rajesh Khajuria SHO Batote, Insp P D Singh SHO Chanderkote, Insp Nayeem Mattoo SHO Ramban, Insp Afzal Wani SHO Banihal, Insp Manoj Kumar SHO Dharamkund and Insp Nazir Ahmad SHO Gool.

Doda man commits murder during Facebook live

DODA: A man from Doda was live-streaming on Facebook on Friday when he committed murder following a heated argument with the victim over some dispute. Accused Bharo Singh from the Bhalessa area of Doda killed Ram Singh of Dhossa during a Facebook Live.

The video of the incident shows Bharo Singh disgruntled over "his stones" being used to construct a house. He is also seen repeatedly threatening in the video.

"I told him and Sarpanch many times to return my stones...My stones have been used to construct your house...I asked Panehayat, tehsildar and others but no one helped me. Bhairo Singh will also kill himself," the accused said on Facebook Live while showing an axe.

The clip shows him having a bitter argument with Ram Singh in the presence of his daughter and wife. Bharo later attacks Ram with the axe and runs from the spot.

The accused has been arrested by the police in an injured condition. He attempted to end his life when he saw cops coming, sources said.

Doda Police said that it was learnt through reliable sources at Police station Gandoh that one Bharov Singh son of Pawan Kumar resident of Chouanry Gandoh attacked Ram Krishan son of Nand Lal resident of village Dhosa Gandoh with an axe and committed his murdered on spot. In this incident one lady namely Anju Devi wife of Chander Parkash resident of Chouanry Gandoh was also injured severely who was referred to Doda for treatment.

Immediately after the receipt of the information, Adil Hussain, SDPO Gandoh and Insp Vikram Singh, SHO Gandoh alongwith a Police Party rushed to the spot and after hectic efforts and tactfully arrested the accused person from high ridges of forest area. The accused person while being arrested got himself injured with the weapon of offence(axe).

FIR No 55/2023 under sec 302,307 ,342 has been registered in Police station Gandoh and investigation set into motion.

Prima facie the incident seems to have happened on some old family disputes and grudges between two groups. Initially there were some heated arguments on the dispute of stones extraction which later led to the incident of murderous attack. However investiga-



tion of the case is going on and the evidence is being gathered by Police during investigation.

BSF constable dies of cardiac arrest

As per details, Constable identified as Patil of 91 Battalion stationed at Naugam was found dead, leading to speculation that he has died due to cardiac arrest. To ally any doubts, the body has been sent for post-mortem for factual details about his death.

Panic grips Mendhar area after two suspicious bags found

Three narco smugglers arrested with heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Friday nabbed three narco smugglers and recovered 11 grams of heroin from three different accused in the areas under the jurisdiction Police Station Bishnah, Police Posts Sidhra and Gadigarh.

As per details, a team of Police Station Bishnah led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Bishnah Insp Vikram Sharma while on Naka duty at Mehmoopur area rounded up a suspected person. During search, 5 grams of heroin was recovered from the accused later identified as Nipun Saini, son of BS Saini, resident of Greater Kailash Jammu. He was arrested and FIR No. 151/23 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Bishnah.

Similarly, another team of Police Post Sidhra led by SDPO Nagrota Akash Kohli assisted by SHO Nagrota Insp Vishav Partap Singh and In-Charge Police Post Sidhra PSI Arun Kumar while on Naka duty at Naka Point Tawi Bridge Sidhra area rounded up a suspected person coming on a vehicle (JK02BB 6170). During search, 02 grams of heroin was recovered from the accused later identified as Davinder Kumar, son of Des Raj, resident of Seri Panjgrain Tehsil Nagrota Distt Jammu. He was arrested and FIR No. 265/2023 under section 8/21/22 NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Nagrota. Also, another team of Police Post Gadigarh led by SDPO South Sachit Sharma assisted by SHO Satwari Insp Sumeet Sharma, In-Charge Police Post Gadigarh SI now Insp Ravinder Singh and SI Hans Raj while on Naka duty at Babiliana area rounded up a suspected person coming on a vehicle (JK02AU 6450). During search, 04 grams of heroin was recovered from the accused later identified as Vinit Kumar alias Vinni, son of Naresh Kumar, resident of Rani Talab Digiana. In this regard, cognizance has been taken at Police Post Gadigarh and accused got arrested.

Gang of thieves busted; 3 arrested, stolen gold, silver items, cash recovered

JAMMU: Police on Friday busted a gang of thieves by arresting 3 thieves and recovered stolen gold and silver items alongwith cash Rs 16,200.

As per details, several complaints were lodged at Police Station Gangyal regarding thefts in the areas. During questioning accused confessed their involvement in the various cases and on their disclosure 5.5 tolas of gold items, 2 tolas of silver items and cash Rs 16,200 was recovered from their possession. It is pertinent to mention that accused were involved in FIR No. 46/23 under sections 454/380 IPC, FIR No. 67/23 under sections 457/380 IPC and FIR No. 454/380 IPC of the same operation.

This police operation was done under the supervision of SP South Shaheen Wahid.

Girl found hanging
