CRIME REPORT

Four vehicles seized for illegal transportation of minor minerals

POONCH: On the direction of Deputy Commissioner Poonch, Yasin M. Choudhary, the Mining Department in the presence of DMO Poonch, Javid Iqbal has successfully seized four vehicles involved in the illegal transportation of minor minerals in different parts of the Poonch district.

53 bovines rescued, 7 smugglers arrested

REASI: In drive against bovines smuggling in District Reasi, teams of District Police Reasi laid special Nakas, arrested 7 bovine smugglers and rescued 53 bovines being illegally carried by them.

Team of Police Station Mahore laid a surprise naka at Arital, Mahore Area during checking, intercepted one person namely Farooq Ahmed, son of Abdul Hamid, resident of Nihoch Tehsil Mahore District Reasi and rescued 13 bovines from his possession. FIR No. 67/2023 under section 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Mahore and investigation initiated.



In another incident, Team of Police Station Mahore laid a surprise naka at Gajnwali, Mahore Area during checking, intercepted one person namely Saliman, son of Ali Mohd, resident of Sidhar Tehsil Mahore District Reasi and rescued 6 bovines from his possession. FIR No. 68/2023 under section 188 IPC was registered at Police Station Mahore.

In another incident, a team of Police Station Mahore laid a surprise Naka at Kaidora, Mahore Area during checking, intercepted one person namely Farooq Mohd Ashraf, son of Abdul Rehman, resident of Nihoch Tehsil Mahore District Reasi and rescued 14 bovines from his possession. FIR No. 69/2023 under section 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Mahore.

In another incident, a team of Police Post Thanole rescued 6 bovines at Khandi Gali, Dhakikote from the clutches of Bovine Smuggler namely Bhutto Khan, son of Qasam Din, resident of Chak Mathiyani, Tehsil Khwaas, District Rajouri who was carrying Bovines by foot towards Srinagar without DM permission. FIR No. 65/2023 under sections 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Arnas and accused arrested.

While foiling another incident, team of Police Station Chassana rescued 14 bovines at Sungri Kotli from the clutches of Bovine Smugglers namely Mithu, son of Noora; Mohd Latif, son of Mohd Bashir; Both residents of Jij Bagli Tehsil Thakrakote District Reasi and Mohd Shafi Chae, son of Mohd Qasim Chae, resident of Kund Masjid Sharief Waltengo Tehsil Devsar District Kulgam who was carrying bovines by foot towards Srinagar without DM permission. FIR No. 28/2023 under section 188 IPC, 11 PCA Act has been registered at Police Station Chassana and accused were arrested.

Drug peddler arrested; contraband recovered

HANDWARA: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, Police on Saturday arrested a drug peddler in Handwara and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party of Police Station Kralgrund at a checkpoint established at Kralgrund near Eidgah, intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot after noticing police party but was apprehended tactfully. He has been identified as Mohd Amin Bhat alias Umar, son of Rayaz Ahmad resident of Kralgrund. During search, 40 grams of Charas was recovered from his possession.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No.49/2023 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Kralgrund and investigation has been initiated.

Notorious criminal booked under PSA

RAJOURI: Further tightening its noose against notorious criminals who become a threat for peace and order in the society, police authorities in Rajouri have detained a notorious criminal under Public Safety Act (PSA).

Police stated that a notorious criminal namely Mohd Kabir son of Feroz Din resident of Nerojal, Tehsil Thanamandi, District Rajouri has been booked under Public Safety Act for repeated criminal activities which are highly prejudicial and detrimental to the maintenance of public order.

Police further said that the accused has not changed his behaviour inspite of lodging multiple FIR's against him and arrest by police number of times.

The person is hell bent upon carrying burglaries, thefts and extortion in different parts of J&K and such activities are likely to disturb public order particularly in Rajouri district.

Police said that the accused is already booked in many cases that include FIR No 320/2016 under section 337 RPC of police station Rajouri, FIR No 75/2011 under sec-

tions 457/380 IPC of PS Rajouri, FIR No 332/2012 under sections 457/380 RPC of PS Rajouri, FIR No 12/2012 under sections 323/324 RPC of PS Thanamandi, FIR No 155/2021 under sections 307/323/511/380/457 IPC of PS Manjakote, FIR No 162/2021 under sections 307/323/ 511/380/457 IPC of PS Manjakote, FIR No 85/2023 under sections 457/380/201 IPC of PS Nowshera, FIR No 20/2023 under sections 457/380 IPC of PS Nowshera, FIR No 36/2010 under section 279 RPC of PS Rajouri, FIR No: 85/2017 under sections 307/341/225/353/342/147/148 RPC of PS Thanamandi.

Keeping in view the activities of said accused as his activities amounts to pose serious threat to public order and deserves to be taken into preventive custody, as such, the accused is ordered to be detained under section 8 (1) (a) (i) read with clause (ii) of sub-section (2) of section 8 of Jammu & Kashmir Public Safety Act.

The order of detention under PSA has been executed by police team headed by SHO Thanamandi, Azhar Hilal under the supervision of SDPO Thanamandi Dr. Imtiaz Ahmed.

Theft case solved, 2 arrested, stolen items recovered

JAMMU: Policed on Saturday solved a theft case by arresting two accused and recovered stolen items.

As per details, a complaint was lodged by one person namely Vikramjeet, resident of Gidder Gallian presently working as Ac mechanic at a shop at Dharp, stating that during intervening night some unknown persons broke the lock of his shop and stolen number of items like copper wire, ac compressor etc. In this regard, FIR No. 119/2023 under section 457/380 IPC was also registered at Police Station Satwari and investigation started.

On this, a team led by SHO Satwari Inspr Sumeet Sharma and In-Charge Police Post Gadigarh SI now Inspr Ravinder Singh with the help of CCTV footages of the area round-up two suspected persons namely Mohd. Firdous, son of Mohd. Shahjahan Sheikh, resident of Kolkata West Bengal at present Chatha and Mohd. Rubal Sheikh, son of Mohd. Wahab Sheikh, resident of West Bengal at present Chatha. During questioning accused confessed their involvement in the various cases and on their disclosure stolen items were recovered from their possession which include 18 Gas cylinders, Two microwave oven, one split AC, Three voltage stabilisers, Eleven binding motors; Copper wires; Other electronics items and other items; One scooter (JK02 BK 9277); Two fire extinguisher cylinder; Two cutted AC compressor; One cutted window AC and Two demolished AC bodies and one tri-cycle was also recovered which was used for commission of offence.

The overall operation was done under the supervision of SP City South Shaheen Wahid.

Non-local's body found in Jhelum river

SOPORE: The body of missing non-local was recovered from Sopore area on Saturday. The police said that 24-year-old Pintu, a resident of Ferozabad in Uttar Pradesh, was missing since June 13.

"His body was recovered today from the Jhelum river in Tulibal area of Sopore sub-division. Medico-legal formalities are now being completed," the police said.
