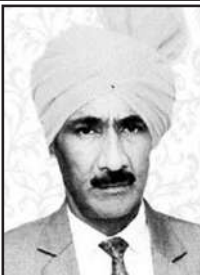

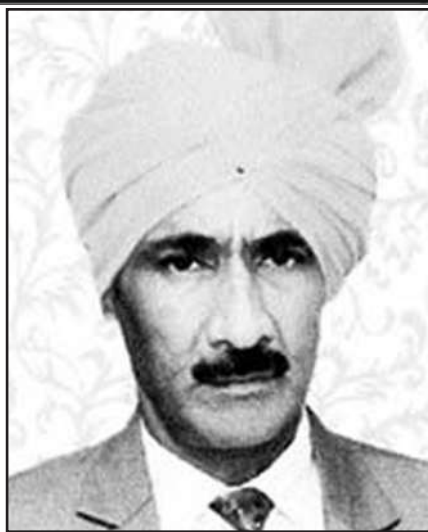
SHRADHANJALI

CRIME REPORT

32 bovines rescued, 3 smugglers arrested

REASI: In drive against bovine smugglers in two different incidents, Reasi Police on Friday arrested 3 bovine smugglers while rescuing 32 bovines being illegally carried by them.

As per details, team of Police Station laid a surprise Naka at Goraban Sarsote Teh Chassana during checking, intercepted two persons namely Abdul Rshid, son of Gulzar Ahmed and Manzoor Ahmed, son of Abdul Rashid, both residents of Malikote Tehsil Chassana District Reasi and rescued 18 bovines from his possession FIR No. 34/2023 U/S 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Chassana and investigation initiated.

In another incident, on the same spot team of Police Station Chassana during surprise Naka checking foiled bovines smuggling attempt by arresting a person namely Shams Din, son of Gulam Mohd, resident of Malikote while one person namely Manzoor Ahmed, son of Mohd Yousf fled away, who is going towards Kashmir along with 14 bovines, during enquiries DM permission was not found. In this regards, a case FIR No. 35/2023 U/S 188 IPC has been registered at Police Station Mahore and investigation initiated.

2 excavators, 1 LNT machine seized for illegal mining

DODA: Enforcement teams on Friday seized two trolleys and two heavy excavators involved in illegal mining in the Bhalla area.

The operation was conducted jointly by the revenue department and team of the geology and mining Department. District Mineral Officer, Sunil Kumar Manhas, Naib Tehsildar Bhalla and the local Choki Officer were part of the inspection team.

Similarly in the preceding days, the DMO Doda, along with the Naib Tehsildar Bhalla, seized one LNT machine and the dumps of crushed material at Dar Crusher in Bhaderwah.

The seizure operations were carried out in accordance with the laws outlined in the Mineral Act.

By taking decisive action against the illegal mining activities, the authorities have demonstrated their unwavering commitment to uphold the law and preserve the natural resources in the region.

Police destroys poppy cultivation

Drug peddler arrested, contraband recovered

KULGAM: Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police have arrested a drug peddler in Kulgam and recovered contraband substance from his possession.

As per details, a party headed by In-charge Police Post Frisal at a checkpoint established at Chenigam, Frisal intercepted a vehicle (auto) bearing registration No. JK18B-2131 driven by Rouf Ahmad Bhat son of Ghulam Hassan Bhat resident of Chenigam. During search, 17 Kgs of Poppy Straw like contraband substance was recovered from the said vehicle. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody. Vehicle used in commission of crime was also seized.

Accordingly, a case vide FIR No. 63/2023 under relevant sections of law has been registered in Police Station Yaripora and investigation has been set into motion.

Woman among two narco-smugglers nabbed; 28 grams heroin recovered

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Friday nabbed two narco smugglers including a woman and recovered 28 grams of heroin from two accused peddlers.

As per details, a team of Police Post Narwal led by SDPO East Syed Zaheer Abbas Jafari assisted by SHO PS Bahu Fort Inspnr Shiv Dev Singh and In-Charge Police Post Narwal SI Lalit Sharma along with team of lady constables while on patrolling duty near Rajiv Nagar chowk area rounded up a suspected woman namely Poonam, wife of Satveer, resident of Rajiv Nagar. During search, 20 grams of heroin was recovered from her possession.

Also another team of Police Post Narwal rounded up a suspected person namely Narinder Singh, son of Suram Singh, reside of Qasim Nagar Narwal who was coming from Rajiv Nagar towards Chowk. During search, 8 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession.

Duo was arrested and FIR No.179, 177/2023 under sections 8/21/22 NDPS Act respectively was registered against them at Police Station Bahu Fort. The whole operation was done under the supervision of SP South Shaheen Wahid.



2 bike lifters arrested, two stolen bikes recovered

JAMMU: Police on Friday nabbed two bike lifters and recovered two stolen bikes.

As per details, On June 15, 2023, one complaint was lodged at Police Post Canal Road by one person namely Rakesh Kumar, son of Banarsi Dass, resident of Lajpat Nagar Jammu regarding theft of his Suzuki Hayate motorcycle (JK02BH-3807). In this regard, FIR No. 92/2023 under section 379 IPC got registered at Police Station Nowabad and investigation started.

After this, a team of Police Station Nowabad led by Dy:SP Hqrs Jammu Dr Sunniya Wani assisted by SHO Nowabad Inspnr. Surinder Raina assisted by In-Charge Police Post Canal Road PSI Mohd Younis Khanday and In-Charge Police Post Talab Tillo PSI Sonu Choudhary with the help of CCTV footages of the area rounded up the suspected persons namely Arjun Sharma alias Goludu, son of Vinod Kumar, resident of Rajinder Nagar Bazar Peer Mitha Jammu at present Gole Pulli Talab Tillo Jammu and Sandeep Kumar, son of Kartik Kumar, resident of Dhopipura Chatigarh at present Gole Pulli Talab Tillo Jammu. On their disclosure stolen motorcycle (JK02BH-3807) was recovered. Moreover 01 more motorcycle (Pulsar 150 CC) bearing Regd. No JK02-AS-4162 got recovered from their possession.

2 mobile snatchers arrested

BISHNAH: Police on Friday nabbed two mobile snatchers.

As per details, On June 23, 2023, a written complaint was lodged at this Police Station Bishnah by the complainant namely Asha Ram, son of Sain Dass, resident of Majna, Bishnah stating that he was going for walk and suddenly two persons on motorcycle (JK02CJ-0814) came and snatched his Samsung Mobile

Phone and fled away from the spot. On the receipt of information, FIR No. 156/2023 under section 382 IPC was registered and investigation started. After this, a team of Police Station Bishnah led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Police Station Bishnah Inspnr Vikram Sharma did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area and other technical aids finally



arrested two accused persons namely Govind Kumar, son of Ram Dhan and Vishal Kumar, son of Mangat Ram, both residents of Bhagwana Chak Tehsil Bishnah, Distt Jammu involved in above said case. On their disclosure, snatched mobile was recovered from their possession and the bike used for commission of offence was also seized.

Woman arrested; 40 litres of illicit liquor recovered, 300 litres of Lahan destroyed

JAMMU: Police on Friday nabbed a woman and recovered 40 litres of illicit liquor from her possession and destroyed 300 litres of Lahan.

As per details, a team of Police Station Akhnoor while on patrolling duty received the information regarding a woman is selling illicit liquor near Jadh Jourian area.

On this, a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal Sharma assisted by SHO Akhnoor Inspnr Zaheer Mushtaq and In-Charge Police Post Jourian PSI Karnail Singh did strenuous efforts and finally raided at the suspected place and rounded up one woman who was selling and preparing illicit liquor. During search, 40 litres of illicit liquor was recovered and 300 litres of Lahan was destroyed on the spot. The accused woman was later identified as Joginder Kour, wife of Chain Singh, resident of Jadh Teh Jourian District Jammu. She was arrested and FIR No 173/2023 under sections 48-a 48-e 48-f Excise Act was registered against her at Police Station Akhnoor.
