Bn Vide his office order No. 962 of 2010 dated:- 27-03-2010 and you joined the Department on the same date i.e 27-03-2010.
- Whereas, you remained posted in several Battalions and instantly you are posted in this unit since 28/05/2018, holding the rank of Constable under Regt. No. 834/IRP-10th Bn. and were further deployed in A-Coy of this unit to perform General Duties.
- Whereas, on 20-03-2023 during your posting on A Coy of this unit on th pretext of having some urgent work at your home succeeded to get (3+1) days casual leave w.e.f 16-03-2023 and accordingly a departure report to this effect stand recorded in A Coy daily diary vide DD Report No. 03 dated:- 16-03-2023 and was due to report back for duties after availing the granted leave period on 20-03-2023 FN, which you failed to do, so, Accordingly your absence stand diarized in Coy daily diary vide DD report No. 04 of Date 20-03-2023 at 1159 hours.
- Whereas, following your prolonged absence, you where informed through your concerned police station by Coy Commander Concerned vide his office signal No. A-Coy/IRP-10th/2023/189 dated 29-03-2023, as well as by this office signed No. Estt/PF-834/IRP-10th/2023/7180 Dated:- 01-04-2023, followed by Coy Commander Concerned Signal No. 201 Dated:- 05-04-2023, No. 216 Dated:- 13-04-2023 & No. 244 Dated:- 26-04-2023 to resume your duties, but your neither resumed your duties nor anything has been heard from your end responding your well being and whereabouts.
- Whereas, following your prolonged absence and not responding to the communications made by this office as well as of your coy Commander, you were placed under suspension vide this office order no. 121 of 2023 dated:- 15-05-2023 with immediated effect and also a departmental enquiry into your conduct has been ordered and entrusted to Coy Commander A Coy of this unit for holding the same.
- Whereas, a special representative (SgCt Susheel Koul No. 689/IRP -10th) has also deputed to your home to inform you Physically who also informed you to resume your duties and your also ensured for resumption of duties on next day i.e 10-06-2023.
- Whereas, despite of above, you have not resumed your duties till date and shows your clear disinterest to serve the department any more.
- Whereas, on perusal of your previous service Profile, it reveals that from the date of your initial appointment on 27-03-2010, till date you have been awarded (03) Major Punishments in the shape of Stoppage of Annual Increment/ Forfeiture respectively and also (384) days of your service have been treated as Diesnon on several occasions from which it depicts that in previous service tenure too, you have not remained duty bound/law abiding official instead is a clear habitual of absenteeism.
- Whereas, on your total failure to resume your duties despite of being informed several times either by Coy Commander Concerned or by this Headquarters, it clearly depicts that you are not interested to serve the department anymore and your further formal existence on the rolls of this unit is of having no means and you deserves to be removed from services on account of your previous service profile and instant prolonged absence.

- The L-1 Contractor shall deposit the Performance Security within 10 days after issuance of LOI failing which the concerned Tender Inviting Authority shall forfeit the EMD and recommend the Contractor for blacklisting and the tender will be issued a fresh.
- The Contractor shall start the execution of work within 10 days after the allotment of work failing which the contract will be terminated and fresh tender will be invited after imposing penalties, forfeiting of 05% Performance Security and shall recommend the Contractor for blacklisting.
- All the Bituminous Material shall be prepared in Hot Mix Plant and shall be laid on site with Mechanized Pavers.

- It should also be ensured that quantity of item executed at site should not exceed advertised Quantities as per the BOQ in any case in order to ensure that intense position of the bidders does not get changed.
- A Bid which contains several items in the Bill of Quantities which are unrealistically priced low and which cannot be substantiated satisfactorily by the bidder may be rejected as non- responsive.

- The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reasons. All the required information for bids must be filled and submitted online. The bidder should recheck his documents before online submission otherwise incomplete documents / damaged / corrupt file / corrupt document shall not be considered/entertained & in such a case the bidder shall be straightway rejected during pre-technical qualification.
- Bidders are advised not to make any changes in BOQ (Bill of Quantities) contents or its name. In no case they should attempt to create similar BOQ manually.
- The Firm /contractor along with concerned field staff Engineers shall be responsible for quality & workmanship of the work.
- If extra item required to complete the work, then the payment for these items shall be made on overall appreciation / depreciation of allotment over SSR applicable.
- Any item or items beyond the advertised rate list if found necessary during the execution of the said work shall be got executed only after getting the prior approval from the competent Authority and the same shall be paid as per the over all appreciation/depreciation offered by the bidder.
