those who brought guns to Kashmir were not well-wishers of the people here. Later, inaugurating or laying foundation stones of various development projects in Kashmir Valley, Shah said the situation in Jammu and Kashmir was peaceful now and the successful hosting of a G20 meeting in Srinagar proved it.

He said the development funds used to go into the pockets of a few earlier but now all those deserving are getting the fruits of development.

He said that when it was decided to hold a meeting of the G20 in Srinagar, many people offered various comments and some, including former chief minister Mehbooba Mufti, made various predictions.

"But all these predictions were proved wrong as the G20 meeting in Srinagar

was held successfully," he said and appreciated the Jammu and Kashmir adminstration headed by Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha for it. He also said the successful hosting of the G20 meeting would give a big boost to

the tourism industry in Kashmir.

The meeting of the G20 tourism working group was held in Kashmir last month. The Home Minister claimed that during earlier regimes, funds meant for the

poor and farmers used to go into the pockets of a few. "Many in Jammu and Kashmir have big houses in foreign lands and many used

to go for 45-60 days' vacations in foreign countries. Where did this money come from? This was money meant for the poor," he said.

Now development funds are reaching actual beneficiaries through direct benefit transfer (DBT), he said.

In the last four years, the government built about 1.86 lakh houses for people in Jammu and Kashmir and Rs 23,000 crore was given to beneficiaries of various schemes through DBT.

The home minister also appealed to people to come forward and join hands in the march for development and fulfil Prime Minister Narendra Modi's dream of a peaceful and prosperous Jammu and Kashmir.

"(Narendra) Modi replaced the UPA government, which was involved in scams vorth Rs 12 lakh crore. The prime minister has laid a strong foundation for a corruption-free India," he said, addressing a public rally here.

"Three families ruled Jammu and Kashmir for decades together and there was no development due to Article 370. As many as 42,000 people died due to terrorism and they are saying we should have kept Article 370 safeguarded," Shah said. The Home Minister said he wanted to ask NC president Farooq Abdullah and PDP chief Mehbooba Mufti that who is responsible for the death of the 42,000 people because their parties were in power in the erstwhile state at that time.

"Under Modi, the noose around terrorism has been tightened," he said, adding that under the prime minister's leadership, Jammu and Kashmir has started its journey on the path of progress.

Shah, who started his two-day visit to Jammu and Kashmir by paying tributes to BJP ideologue Syama Prasad Mookerjee at the party headquarters here, said it was the latter's sacrifice, motivation and pledge that there is no Article 370 today in Jammu and Kashmir and the Union Territory has been completely integrated with the country.

"Mookerjee is also credited with connecting West Bengal with India. He resigned as a minister (in 1953 from then prime minister Jawaharlal Nehru's cabinet) to launch his campaign for "ek desh mein do vidhan, do pradhan aur do nishan nahi chalenge" (there cannot be two sets of law, two chiefs and two symbols in a country) and reached Jammu and Kashmir," he said.

Alleging that Mookerjee was killed in Jammu and Kashmir after his arrest for entering the region without a permit, Shah said his soul would be in peace after

the abrogation of Article 370. He also remembered the role of Pt. Prem Nath Dogra in the nationalist struggles in Jammu & Kashmir.

He said India is celebrating nine years of PM Modi's rule. He said there is not even a single corruption allegation against Modiji in 9 years of governance as it

has worked hard to end corruption in the system. The Modi government has reached every needy person who was neglected for all previous years, while he counted the major development works in J&K undertak-

en recently. He said that J&K has progressed on the path of development. Whole J&K population is getting the benefits of Ayushman Gold Card. He men-

tioned the Tirupati Bala ji temple, which has been opened recently. He said gone are the days, when the three families would rule and ruin J&K. Lauding people for turning up in good numbers for the rally despite the scorching heat, the Home Minister said "a new Jammu and Kashmir is in the making

ander the Modi government". Referring to a terror incident and the subsequent reaction of Mufti, he said, "I want to tell Mufti and Abdullah that there has been a 70-per cent drop in terror activities during the nine years of the NDA rule (in Jammu and Kashmir), com-

pared to the previous 10 years of the UPA government. "Under the 10 years of the UPA government, 7.327 terror incidents took place, whereas the number stands at 2,350 in nine years of the NDA government.

Shah said 2,056 civilians were killed in Jammu and Kashmir when the Congress-led United Progressive Alliance (UPA) was in power at the Centre from 2004 to 2014, while the number stands at only 377 under the BJP-led National Democratic Alliance (NDA) government.

The number of separatist-sponsored calls for strikes dropped to 32 after the abrogation of Article 370, while there has been a 90-per cent decline in stone-pelting incidents, he said, adding, "This shows that the situation in Jammu and Kashmir is improving and all sections of the society including the deprived Gujjars and Paharis, are getting their rights and justice."

Lauding Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha and security forces for a successful conduct of a G20 meeting in Srinagar last month, he alleged that some political parties joined Pakistan in opposing the event and added that it has proved to be beneficial in conveying the message that the situation has improved Jammu and

"The tourist footfall in 2022 touched 1.88 crore, which is a record. During the rule of the three families, not even 50 per cent of such an arrival was recorded," Shah said.

He said 28,000 youngsters have been given government jobs in a transparent manner since 2014, while 51,000 have been provided with self-employment opportunities and 70,000 others linked to the "Mission Youth".

An industrial package of Rs 28,400 crore has been given to Jammu and Kashmir by the BJP government, the home minister said, adding that the youngsters who had stones in their hands earlier have now been equipped with laptops

and they are re-writing their future as also taking care of the country's future. "The investment (in Jammu and Kashmir) is growing after the introduction of the industrial policy, the industrial land allotment policy, the private industrial

estate development policy, the food processing, handicraft and handloom policy, the new film policy, the tourism homestay and sports policy," he said. In his address that lasted for more than 20 minutes, Shah also talked about the successful conduct of the Panchayati Raj Institution polls and said 32,000 panch-

prayers to Lord Venkateshwara, while the priests chanted shlokas, Thalari Ravi, the PRO of Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD), told PTI.

The temple of Lord Sri Venkateswara Swamy was inaugurated by Sinha, Union ministers Dr Jitendra Singh and G Kishen Reddy on June 8.

Initially, Shah was scheduled to virtually inaugurate the temple but could not take part in the event due to some indispensable work, Sinha had said during the

While he was at the party office in Trikutanagar on Friday, Shah held discussions with BJP leaders to gather feedback on the prevailing situation in Jammu and Kashmir.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Friday laid the foundation stone of a central forensic science laboratory in Samba and inaugurated several development projects in Jammu.

over a decade, representing certain key sectors of the economy such as steel, aluminium, renewable energy, solar products, and certain key export-related measures. This mutually agreed solution negotiated by both sides marks the culmination of protracted negotiations, and it is unprecedented in WTO history, the commerce ministry said.

He also said that as a result of the agreement, exports of certain steel and aluminium products from India to the US would get an exemption from additional

"They (US) have assured us that all exclusion (from additional duties) requests that India makes or US importer makes...They have given an assurance that at least 70 per cent of all such requests for steel and 80 per cent of all such requests for aluminium for products originating from India will be excluded from the additional process of Section 252 (of a US law)," Goyal said.

These remarks assume significance as in 2018, the US imposed 25 per cent and 10 per cent import duties on certain steel and aluminium products, respectively, on grounds of national security.

The US administration had imposed these duties using Section 232 of an act that permits the president to restrict imports.

In retaliation, India in June 2019 imposed customs duties on 28 American products, including chickpeas, lentils, almonds, walnuts, apples, boric acid, and diagnostic reagents. India had also filed a complaint against the US in WTO on imposing these duties.

The United States Trade Representative (USTR) said that the two countries "have agreed to terminate six outstanding disputes" at the WTO.

On India's decision to remove retaliatory customs duties on certain American products like chickpeas, lentils, almonds, walnuts, apples, boric acid, and diagnostic reagents, USTR Katherine Tai said that these tariff cuts will restore and expand market opportunities for US agricultural producers and manufacturers. Trade experts stated that the move will help boost two-way commerce and strengthen economic ties.

Welcoming the decision, think-tank GTRI co-founder Ajay Srivastava said it is expected that the agreement also includes a commitment from the US to eliminate additional tariffs on steel and aluminium imported from India.

The US is the largest trading partner of India. In 2022-23, the bilateral goods trade increased to USD 128.8 billion as against USD 119.5 billion in 2021-22. According to WTO rules, a member country can file a case in the Geneva-based multilateral body if they feel that a particular trade measure is against the norms

Bilateral consultation is the first step to resolving a dispute. If both sides are not able to resolve the matter through consultation, either of them can approach the establishment of a dispute settlement panel.

The panel's ruling or report can be challenged by WTO's appellate body.

of the world body.

Interestingly, the appellate body is not functioning because of differences among member countries to appoint its members. Several disputes are already pending with this body. The US has been blocking the appointment of the members.

Further, the joint statement also said that India has highlighted its interest in the restoration of its status under the US Generalized System of Preferences (GSP) programme, which could be considered in relation to eligibility criteria determined by the US Congress.

On this, Goyal said that India and the US have agreed to discuss New Delhi's demand for restoration of GSP benefits to domestic exporters and now both sides will commence discussions to find a solution.

GSP allows eligible developing countries to export duty-free goods to the US. A number of Indian products from sectors such as chemicals and engineering were getting duty-free access to the US market under the GSP, introduced in 1976.

The US has assured that they will consider that and "we will discuss that and find some solution," he added. But ultimately it's the US Congress which will have to take a final decision "but

discussions will now commence on that issue," he told reporters here.
