Army officer kills self

Two narco smugglers nabbed with 29 grams heroin

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Sunday nabbed two narco smugglers and recovered 29 grams of heroin from them.

As per details, a team of Police Station Janipur led by SDPO West Vikram Singh assisted by SHO Janipur Inspr Sikander Singh while on patrolling duty near Kesav Nagar Janipur Colony rounded up two suspected persons. During search, 29 grams of heroin was recovered from them.

FIR No.66/2023 u/s 8/21/22/29 NDPS Act was registered at Police Station Janipur and both the accused were arrested who have been identified as Gulcharan Singh, son of Lt. Royal Singh, resident of H.No 59 W.No 11 Raghunath Pura Udhampur and Ashwani Sharma, son of Kewal Sharma, resident of Majalta Udhampur.

Mentally disturbed person handed over to family

JAMMU: Police on Sunday handed over a mentally disturbed person to his family.

As per details, an information was received at Police Station Khour through reliable sources that a mentally disturbed person namely Kushapal, son of Dev Parkash, resident of Uspar, Near Sonik Road, Mathura, U.P was

roaming in the area. On this, a team of Police Station Khour brought the person to Police Station Khour and offered him meals.

After this, a team of Police Station Khour led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal assisted by SIO Khour Inspr Rahul Mahajan did strenuous efforts and in this regard Police Station Highway, Mathura UP was contacted officially for his verification and with the help of various sources contacted the family of the person. The family of the person disclosed that the above mentioned person is mentally unsound and had gone missing from his home.

The person was finally handed over to his family members after completing all the legal formalities.

Drug peddler nabbed with 850 ampoules of psychotropic substance

JAMMU: Continuing its drive against drug trafficking and substance abuse, Police on Sunday nabbed a drug peddler and recovered 850 ampoules of psychotropic substance from his possession.

As per details, a team of Police Station Pacea Danga led by SDPO North Sunil Kumar Kesar assisted by SHO Pacea Danga Inspr Sushil Kumar while on Naka duty at Manda Nakka rounded up a suspected person who was coming on his vehicle (JK02CE-2485) who was coming from Nagrota side towards Jammu. During search, 850 ampoules of Diazepam injections of 2 ml each were recovered from the accused later identified as Mohit Sharma, son of Madan Lal, resident of near Tehsil office Kandoli Nagrota Jammu. He was arrested and FIR No. 81/2023 under section 8/21/22/NDPS Act was registered against him at Police Station Pacea Danga.

65 smugglers booked, 268 animals rescued, 27 vehicles seized

RAJOURI: In order to tighten noose against the unlawful practice of bovine smuggling, Rajouri police has registered fifty one FIRs, booked sixty five smugglers and rescued two hundred and sixty eight bovine animals from their clutches in last one week.

Twenty seven vehicles, mostly light holds carrier, have also been seized in the action for being used in smuggling.

Rajouri Police in its official statement mentioned about drive

against bovine smuggling which aims to keep a check on this unlawful practice.

In its action, Rajouri police said, fifty one bovines smuggling bids have been foiled across the district in last one week with seventeen bids have been foiled in Rajouri police station alone.

Two hundred and sixty eight bovine animals being smuggled have been rescued during last one week with one hundred and four animals have been rescued from clutches of smugglers in the jurisdiction of Rajouri police station, forty eight in Thanamandi, three in Darhal, twenty in Nowshera, eighteen in Kalakote, forty in Dharamsal, nine in Kandli, fifteen in Budhal, seven in Manjakote and four in Sunderbani.

Most of the bids have been foiled by police during surprise nakas laid at link roads in remote pockets while a around one dozen bids have been foiled in dense forests where smugglers were indulged in bovine smuggling by foot without use of any vehicle.

Police further said that sixty five people have been arrested in the action since last Sunday and action as per law of land has been taken against the accused while twenty seven vehicles, mostly light goods carrier, have been seized.

Senior Superintendent of Police Rajouri Amritpal Singh (IPS) said that Jammu and Kashmir police in Rajouri district has a zero-tolerance policy towards bovine smuggling as it is not only an unlawful act but is also inhumane as bovine animals are smuggled with cruelty.

He said that in all the police stations and police posts in the district, a special drive against bovine smuggling is going on with an aim to curb this crime.

He further stated that besides keeping a check on smuggling of bovines through small link roads in remote pockets, police has also busted modus operandi of smugglers to smuggle bovines from remote forest areas and many bids in dense forests have been foiled in recent days.

SSP Rajouri Amritpal Singh (IPS) further stated that some notorious bovine smugglers in the district have also been detained under preventive sections of law and the action will remain continue.

Missing woman traced reunited with family

KATHUA: Police on Sunday traced a missing woman and reunited her with her family members.

As per complainant, a complaint was lodged at Police Station Rajbagh regarding one missing woman resident of Hamirpur Tehsil Marheen & District Kathua and accordingly a missing report was entered into the daily diary of this

police establishment vide DDR No. 15 on June 6, 2023 and search was started to trace out the missing woman.

Today, a team of Police Station Rajbagh led by Insp. Tariq Ahmed SHO Rajbagh traced out the missing woman and after completing legal formalities, she was handed over to her legal heirs.

3 notorious thieves arrested, stolen property recovered

SAMBA: Police on Sunday arrested 3 notorious thieves thereby solving two theft cases and recovering stolen property.

The arrested notorious thieves have been identified as Noor Aslam Shekh, son of Shah Alam Shekh, resident of Bengal at present TeliBasti Bari Brahmana; Papu Singh, son of Shatrugan, resident of Uttar Pradesh at present Doliian Bari Brahmana and Vikas Kumar, son of Jagdish Raj, resi-



dent of Kathua.

Two theft cases registered at Police Station Bari Brahmana, viz case FIR No.151/2023 under section 457/380 IPC and case FIR No. 152/2023 under section 454/380 IPC have been solved by Police and stolen items worth rupees 53000.00 approximately has been recovered.

These notorious thieves were operative in Samba district for quite long time and used to steal away costly items from godowns and other places after conducting advance reece. Police had been organizing surprise nakas to nab them and thus finally succeeded in apprehending them.

The notorious thieves were arrested by a Police party of Police Station Bari Brahmana headed by SHO Bari Brahmana Sunil Sharma under the supervision of SDPO Bari Brahmana Rahul Nagar.
