## CRIME REPORT

### MC Samba removes encroachment from market

### 8 vehicles seized, 8 arrested for illegal extraction & transportation of minerals

Accordingly, a case under relevant sections of law was registered in Police Station Baramulla and investigation set into motion.

### Theft case solved, accused arrested

**BARAMULLA:** Police on Tuesday solved a theft case by arresting an accused person involved in the commission of crime.

As per details, On June 25, 2023, Police Station Bijhama received a written application from one person Bilal Ahmad Dar son of Khazir Mohd Dar resident of Salamabad Dachina stating therein that some unknown thieves has stolen three goats from Salamabad Daelna jungle. On his disclosure, all the stolen property was recovered. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

After completion of all legal formalities, the stolen property was handed over to the legal owner.

### 3 drug smugglers arrested, contraband substances recovered

**BARAMULLA:** Continuing its efforts to eradicate the menace of drugs from the society, police have arrested 03 drug smugglers on Tuesday and recovered contraband substances from their possession.

As per details, on a specific information regarding presence of contraband substances in the house of Gh Mohammad Tantray son of Habibullah Tantray resident of Mulgam Kunzer, a police party led by SHO Kunzer along with Executive Magistrate concerned raided the specific spot. During the search of house, 13Kgs of Poppy Straw like substance was recovered from the accused who tried to flee but was arrested tactfully. He has been shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Similarly, a party led by SHO Baramulla during patrolling at Khawajabagh Baramulla intercepted a suspicious person who tried to flee from the spot but was apprehended tactfully. During search, 150 grams of Charas like substance was recovered from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody.

Moreover, a police party led by Incharge Police Post Wagoora at a checkpoint established at Vizer Wagoora intercepted a vehicle (Load Carrier) bearing registration number JK05B-1259 driven by one person identified as Ishfaq Ahmad Kaloo son of Nazir Ahmad Kaloo resident of Sher Colony Sopore. During search, 9.5Kgs of Poppy Straw like substance was recovered from his possession. He has been arrested and shifted to police station where he remains in custody. Vehicle used in the commission of crime has also been seized.

Accordingly, cases under relevant sections of law have been registered in respective police stations and further investigation has been initiated.

### Three missing persons traced, reunited with families

On this, a team of Police Station Bishnah led by SDPO RS Pura Nikhil Gogna assisted by SHO Bishnah Insp Vikram Sharma did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally traced the missing person.

And another complaint was lodged at Police Station Akhnoor by the legal heirs of a woman stating that she got missing from her home.

In this regard, missing report on June 25, 2023 was registered at and investigation started. On this, a team of Police Station Akhnoor led by SDPO Akhnoor Mohan Lal assisted by SHO Akhnoor Insp. Zaheer Mushtaq did strenuous efforts and with the help of CCTV footages of the area finally traced the missing lady.

Subsequently families of the missing persons were informed and all the traced persons were handed over to their respective family members after completing all the legal formalities.

### Bootlegger arrested; 15 bottles of illicit liquor recovered
