

STATE TIMES NEWS JAMMU: Asserting that the ground situation in Jammu and Kashmir has changed after the abrogation of Article 370, Union Minister Hardeep Singh Puri on Tuesday said the technical survey on the 175-km Gurdaspur-Jammugas

pipeline has been completed. A final decision on the prestigious project will be taken this month, he added.

The Union Minister of Housing, Urban Affairs, Petroleum and Natural Gas said the real estate summit is on the cards in Srinagar shortly after the successful first-ever such event in Jammu in December 2021.

Puri, who was here to highlight the nine-year achievements of the Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led central

government, said the petrol and natural gas regulatory board is evaluating the bids regard with to Gurdaspur-Jammu pipeline project.

Talking to media persons at BJP headquarters here, he said, "The technical survey has been done and financing (of the project) is underway. The final decision will be taken this month only".

'Opposition politicizing Odisha train incident'

He said the democracy in India is robust and no power can erode it, defending the Income Tax raids on BBC.

He said the "previous actions" of the broadcaster suggested that it was in the hands of the "people with agenda on India". Puri was in Jammu to highlight the achievements of Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led government at the Centre, which recently completed its nine years in power.

"My first engagement on reaching Jammu (on Monday) was a meeting with party workers. We observed a two-minute silence for all the lives lost and to pray for recovery of those injured in the train accident (on June CONTD ON PAGE 9

Govt school principal arrested, suspended after molestation charges

SRINAGAR: The principal of a government school here was arrested on Tuesday in a case of molestation, police said.

The government employee was also suspended and an inquiry ordered after the allegations of molestation were levelled against him.

Shabir Ahmad Mir, resident of Zadibal area of the Srinagar city, working as principal at the Government Higher Secondary School at Gund Hassi Bhat, was taken

into custody after police registered a case against him.

The Srinagar Police, in a tweet, said a case under Indian Penal Code sections 354D (stalking), 294 (obscene acts or using obscene language) and 506 (criminal intimidation) was registered at Shalteng Police Station.


