
DC Rajouri chairs District-Level Bankers' Seminar hosted to address Credit Needs in Agriculture and Allied Sectors

Court frames charges against JE in DA Case

JAMMU: Additional Sessions Judge Anti Corruption, Rajouri Mehmood Chowdhary has framed charge against Romesh Chander S/O Late Patti Ram R/O W. No.5 Jawahar Nagar Rajouri, the then J.E PWD Sub-division Sunderbani Rajouri. The allegation in the charge sheet are that a secret verification conducted in pursuant to a complaint lodged against Romesh Chander wherein it surfaced that suspect has acquired huge assets both movable as well as immovable disproportionate to his non source of income by resorting corrupt and illegal practice by abuse and misuse of his official position. Accordingly FIR N.40/2018 in Offence

U/S 5(1)(e) r/w 5(2) of J&K Prevention of Corruption Act registered and investigation commenced. On the conclusion of investigation it was established that accused has raised, three storey house fully furnished house with modern facilities and costly electronic gadgets at Jawahar Nagar Rajouri, one commercial plot at Jawahar Rajouri, land and building at Dhangri, four Shops constructed on a piece of land at village Dhangri, land measuring, Kanals at Dhangri, two Tipppers Nos. JK11-7736 and JK11-7526, 7- one Luxury car Verma. It has been emerged that accused by taking advantage of his official position is owning a Brick Kiln at Dhangri besides invested proceeds of his ill gotten money in Vikrant finance company Rajouri. The accumulation of property/assets has been raised by the suspect officer either in his own name or in the name of his family members which amounts to criminal misconduct U/S 5(1)(e) r/w 5(2) of J&K Prevention of Corruption Act 2006. After hearing both the sides the court observed that the existence of prima-facie evidence proving grounds for presuming that accused has committed the offence as alleged and the material available on record prima-facie established involvement of the accused in the commission of offence. Accordingly the court framed the charge.

HC upholds acquittal of LeT terrorists

JAMMU: Justice M.A Chowdhary upholds acquittal of LeT terrorists and dismisses the appeal filed by UT. Justice MA Chowdhary while upholding the judgment of trial court, observed that the story of the prosecution otherwise seems to be unreliable in view of the fact that the seven persons allegedly involved in terrorist activities and as alleged by the police to be members of Lashkar-e-Taiba a dreaded organization were sitting like ducks at a public place in Wildlife Sanctuary at Manda waiting for the police to be arrested without any reaction and despite availability of the weapon/explosives they had not used them to retaliate while being arrested by the police. The police had initially registered the case for the commission of the

offences against the State invoking the sedition charges, however, later before filing of the charge sheet those offences were dropped and the charge sheet was laid against the accused for the commission of offences punishable under Arms Act and Explosive Substances Act only. Since most of the prosecution witnesses having failed to identify any of the accused in the court while being examined and the recovery from the possession of the accused of the pistol and the grenades was also doubtful and no independent witness despite availability, was associated with the process of recovery and seizure, the trial court by a very reasoned judgment has held that the prosecution had failed to prove the case to bring home the charge against any of the

accused. Court further observed that prosecution, in the case on hand, has not only failed to produce on record any statement/certificate from any ballistic expert or any expert from FSL to prove that the seized grenades and the pistol had been sent for ballistic examination by the experts. This is also a serious infirmity to be taken into consideration, as in such a situation, the offences of which the accused were alleged to have committed, cannot be said to have been proved. The weapon and explosives, claimed to have been recovered from the accused/respondents, were neither marked on spot, nor sealed, not sent to any Ballistic Expert to examine whether weapon was in working condition or the explosives were live.
