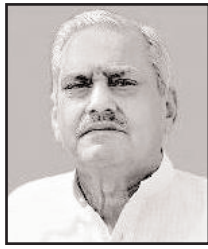

Terrorist attack on pilgrims in Reasi widely condemned

JAMMU: The recent terrorist attack on pilgrims in Reasi has sparked widespread condemnation from various political leaders and organizations, reflecting the collective outrage and grief over this tragic incident.

Dr. Karan Singh (Former Member of Parliament) strongly condemned the ghastly terror attack on pilgrims in Reasi, expressing deep sorrow and outrage. He offered condolences to the families of the victims and urged the Union Government to take immediate measures to curb terrorism in the Jammu region. Dr. Singh emphasized the government's responsibility to ensure people's safety and protect the sanctity of places of worship and pilgrimage sites.

Ritika Trehan, Chief Spokesperson of BJP Mahila Moreha Jammu and Kashmir, strongly condemned the recent terrorist attack on pilgrims in Reasi. Expressing profound grief over the loss of lives and injuries sustained, she termed the attack a crime against humanity and emphasized the need to condemn it unequivocally. Ritika extended her heartfelt condolences to the families of the victims, praying for the departed souls to find solace in the divine realm and for the swift recovery of the injured. Asserting solidarity with the affected families, Ritika invoked Lord Shri Ram's blessings for strength and comfort during this challenging period. She underscored the nation's resolve to stand united against such cowardly acts of terrorism, affirming that those responsible for such atrocities would face justice. Ritika reiterated the nation's commitment to rooting out terrorism,

asserting that the perpetrators would not escape punishment. She emphasized that such acts of violence have no place in India, and the resolve to combat terrorism remains unwavering. In her statement, she highlighted the resilience of the nation in the face of adversity and the determination to confront and defeat terrorism decisively.

Jugal Kishore Sharma, the former Minister and Provincial President of DPAP, in response to the tragic terrorist attack on a bus in Reasi, expressed strong condemnation and deep sorrow over the loss of lives. He emphasized the need for strict action against the perpetrators and called for a thorough investigation to assess the security lapses that led to the attack. Sharma stressed the importance of enhancing security measures to prevent such incidents in the future. Sharma urged both the Central and Union Territory governments to provide adequate compensation to the families of the deceased and the injured. He proposed a compensation of at least Rs 25 lakh for the families of those who lost their lives and Rs 5 lakh for each injured person.

Dr. Parneesh Mahajan, Convenor of the Department of Training for BJP in Jammu & Kashmir, expressed profound grief and anger over the violence inflicted on innocent pilgrims, emphasizing that it's not just an attack on lives but also on the spirit of peace and harmony. Dr. Mahajan reiterated the commitment of the BJP-led government to protect the nation's sovereignty and citizens' well-being. He called for solidarity with the victims' families, speedy recovery for the injured, and emphasized the need for unity against

terrorism.

Dogra Front and Shiv Sena (DFSS) President Ashok Gupta led a protest condemning the attack and burning the Pakistan Flag. The DFSS termed the attack as a crime against humanity and called for strong condemnation and decisive action against terrorists and their supporters. The protest highlighted the previous attack on Amarnath pilgrims and criticized Pakistan's involvement in promoting terrorism. They demanded the destruction of terrorist camps in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir and urged for a forceful response from the government.

Dogra Brahman Pretinidhi Sabha (DBPS) strongly condemned the attack, describing it as sinful and cowardly.
