
# Delhi HC quashes case of outraging modesty against man, asks him to plant 30 trees

NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court has quashed a case against a 61-year-old man after he reached a woman who had accused him of outraging her modesty, and asked him to

plant 30 trees. While dealing with a petition moved by the accused to quash the FIR under IPC section 354 (assault or criminal force to a woman with the intent to outrage her modesty)

registered against him, Justice Anoop Kumar Mendiratta observed that since the matter has been amicably settled, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the case pend-

The continuation of the case would be nothing but an abuse of the process of the court, the judge said.

"Consequently, under sections 354 IPC registered at police station Vasant Kunj, South, and emanating therefrom stand quashed," the court in an order passed last month.

"Instead of imposing the costs upon the petitioner, he is directed to plant 30 saplings of trees, which are up to three feet in height in the local part or in the area of P.S. Vasant Kunj, South after getting in touch with the compeauthority...," ordered.

The court said the upkeep of the saplings shall be undertaken by the authorities concerned and in case of non-compliance of the directions for planting of the trees, the petitioner shall pay costs of Rs 30,000 to the Delhi Legal Services Authority.

In November 2016, the woman accused the petitioner of outraging her modesty.

The court observed that heinous and serious offences involving mental depravity or offences such as murder, rape and dacoity cannot be quashed despite a settlement but offences which have a predominant element of civil dispute or those involving minor incidents, where the complainant or the victim has been compensated, stand on a different foot-

After interacting with the parties, the court said both of them wanted to put an end to the proceedings and the settlement would promote harmony between them and permit them to move forward in

# "Warning bell for us", says Karnataka Cong chief on LS poll outcome, "fact-finding mission" on

BENGALURU: Terming the Lok Sabha election outcome in Karnataka as a "warning bell" to the Congress, its state unit chief D K Shivakumar on Monday indicated that the ruling outfit in the State is currently on a fact-finding mission to find out the reasons for the below par performance.

Also the Deputy Chief Minister, he stressed on the need to look at what went wrong and rectify them, as he called upon party men not to speak before the media regarding the party's performance and blaming someone for it. The NDA got 19 out of 28 Lok Sabha seats in Karnataka. with BJP winning 17 and JD(S) two. The ruling Congress, which banked heavily on the guarantee schemes that its Government had launched and expected them to yield rich electoral dividends, has won nine seats.

"When General Secretary (AICC) and Rahul Gandhi

came to Bengaluru, they told us. We are calling meetings and discussing. Today we have called a meeting to discuss Bengaluru city. For other places too we will fix dates. We need to examine things and review where we have gone wrong, what has happened," Shivakumar told reporters here. He added: "I have asked party men not to speak to the media. Let us do the fact finding on what has happened where, and find solutions."

"People have given us a

warning bell. We need to be careful in the future. At least now we have to realise what has gone wrong, where and we should rectify it," Shivakumar said. Claiming that the party was confident about winning 14-15 seats, Shivakumar said, "we have failed in it. People

have given their verdict." The party has not got votes on the home turf of several of its leaders, he said. "We are verifying why it happened. There may be several individual causes, but defeat is a

# accused to stay in police custody till June 14 PUNE: A Pune court on

Monday extended till June 14, the police custody of the parents of a 17-year-old boy allegedly involved in the fatal Porsche car accident and another accused in a case pertaining to destruction of evidence. The teen's father, realtor Vishal Agrawal, and mother Shivani were arrested in the case for their suspected role in swapping of blood samples of the juvenile, who was allegedly drunk at the time of the May 19 crash in Kalyani Nagar which claimed the lives of two motorbike-borne IT professionals.

Shivani Agarwal was arrested on June 1 after revelation that the boy's blood samples were replaced with hers. Her husband Vishal Agrawal was arrested for allegedly being involved in destruction of evidence. Besides the Agrawal couple, one Ashpak Makandar, who acted as a middleman between

run Sassoon Hospital, where blood samples were collected, were produced before the court on Monday.

The prosecution sought extension of the police custody of the trio arguing they want to find out where the blood samples of the juvenile were disposed off.

It told the court that middle man Makandar was paid Rs 4 lakh by the driver of the teenager's father. Of this, Rs 3 lakh was given further (to Sassoon doctors) for replacing the juvenile's blood samples.

"Rs 3 lakh has been recovered from Dr Srihari Halnor and Sassoon Hospital employee Atul Ghatkamble and we need to recover the remaining Rs 1 lakh," said the investigating offi-

Defence lawyer Prashant Patil opposed the custody extension plea of the teen's parents, saying they have already spent several days in police remand and there was no need for their further custodial interrogation. The minor boy has been sent

to an observation home.

IMPHAL: Manipur Chief Minister N. Biren Singh on Monday condemned the ambush on his advance security convoy near Kotlen in Kangpokpi district in which a driver was injured.

He termed it a direct attack on himself and the people of the state, assuring that the "rule of law" will be estab-

Speaking to reporters at Shija hospital, where the injured person is undergoing treatment, Singh said, "It is very unfortunate and highly condemnable. It's an attack on the chief minister, which means a direct attack on the people of the state. The state government has to do something...we will take a deci-

Singh explained that fortunately the person was not seriously injured. He added, "Earlier, the state government did not retaliate much

He had gone to Delhi to attend the swearing-in ceremony of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, which he described as his responsibility as a Chief Minister.

Earlier in the day, suspected militants ambushed the advance security convoy of Manipur Chief Minister N Biren Singh in Kangpokpi district, leaving rson injured, police said

The convoy was on its way to violence-hit Jiribam district when it came under attack around 10.30 am near Kotlen village along a National Highway-53, they said. Multiple gunshots were fired at the vehicles of the security forces, who retali-

ated, a police officer said. Meanwhile, additional state and central forces, including Assam Rifles and CRPF, rushed to the ambush site and launched search operations to apprehend the perpetrators. However, no arrests have been made.

Jiribam district has been affected by violence since June 6. More than 70 houses have been torched, along with two police outposts and one forest beat office. Around 600 people have been displaced due to the

PUNE: Shrirang Barne, an MP of Shiv Sena led by Eknath Shinde, on Monday expressed disappointment over the party not getting a Cabinet berth in the newlyformed Narendra Modi-led government and alleged par-

Notably, the NCP led by Ajit Pawar, which is also part of the B.IP-led Mahavuti alliance in Maharashtra, on Sunday insisted on a Cabinet berth and refused to settle for a Minister of State offer. Barne, who retained the

Maval seat for the third time by defeating Sanjog Waghere Patil of Shiv Sena (UBT), pointed out that despite Shiv Sena winning seven seats in the recent Lok Sabha elections, the party was only allotted a Minister of State (MOS) position in the Modi 3.0 government. Barne said even likeleaders Kumaraswamy and Jitan Ram Manjhi whose parties won two and one seats, respectively, were made Union cabinet ministers. He mentioned that Udayanraje Bhosale, the BJP MP from Satara, deserved a cabinet position as well. "We were expecting that Shiy Sena would get a Cabinet ministry, but even parties that won only one seat received Cabinet berths. For example, HD Kumaraswamy of JD(S),



secured two berths, and Jitan Ram Manjhi, who won one seat from Bihar, was also given a Cabinet berth," Barne told reporters. Prataprao Jadhav of Shinde Sena was the sole representation in the new Modi government who took oath as a Minister of State with independent charge

Barne added that Shiv Sena had won seven seats in Maharashtra of the 15 contested, whereas BJP bagged nine of 28.

"We were expecting at least one Cabinet and one MOS berth for Shiv Sena which is the oldest ally of BJP," he

Alleging partiality in the distribution of Cabinet berths, Barne claimed that after JD(U) and TDP. Shiv Sena is the third largest ally of the BJP.

"Chirag Paswan, whose party won five seats, was also given a Cabinet berth. But

berth. I personally feel that there is partiality against Shiv Sena. Considering that we will face assembly elections together in the next three months, it is expected that Sena should get fair treatment," he added. He recalled that Eknath Shinde's "bold step" in the state led to the transition of power in Maharashtra.

"Considering all these factors, we expect a justified stance from BJP," Barne

Shinde had split Uddhav Thackeray-led Shiv Sena and joined the BJP-led government in June 2022 with a bulk of MLAs loyal to him. Subsequently, he took oath as the chief minister.

Six MPs from Maharashtra were inducted into the Modi 3.0 coalition government on Sunday, with the BJP securing four berths and allies Shiv Sena and RPI (A) getting one

# Naxal problem now confined to only 5 J'khand districts: DGP

concerted offensives against Naxalites in Jharkhand have restricted their activities to only five of the 24 districts, with Chaibasa being the most affected, DGP Ajay Kumar Singh said on Monday. Continuous operations are underway to minimise the threat posed by the rebels, and their impact is evident in the state Singh added

He made these remarks while speaking to reporters after a review meeting on key issues including law and order, the Naxal menace, and crime control. The DGP expressed confidence that the success of anti-Naxal operations would soon lead to a significant reduction in incidents.

Police have detailed information about Naxalites' movements and hideouts, and operations have been intensified accordingly, he added.

Over 400 Naxalites were arrested last year, he said. Singh also mentioned that spe-

cial campaigns are ongoing to curb drug trafficking and actions have been taken against peddlers under the Drugs and Narcotic Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, resulting in substantial opium recoveries.

The Jharkhand High Court recently criticised the state government for its failure to effectively tackle drug traffick-

It is said there was a move by the Left regime to amend the state liquor policy in favour of bar owners. The Congressled front had demanded the resignation of Tourism and Excise Ministers over the allegations and warned of holding a march towards the state Assembly, intensifying their
