In connection with construction of 4 lane Flyover with paved shoulder configuration along with service road form 4th Tawi Bridge near Bhagwati Nagar Chowk to Bakshi Nagar Canal Head, general public through the medium of this Public Notice/ Advisory is hereby informed that the construction work has been started by the concerned construction agency at Canal Head which will be completed within next 15 days.
