Sunderbani residents protest against PDD for poor power infrastructure

SUNDERBANI: Prominent residents of the border areas of Ghai Upneyas and Anbkhodi staged a strong protest against the Power Development Department (PDD) Sunderbani over the continued neglect of basic infrastructure needs, including the installation of electric poles and a 100 KVA transformer.

The protesters, including Pawan Kumar, Kamal Singh, Ratten Lal, Swati Kumari, Balwan Singh, Babu Ram, Puran Chand, Tilak Raj, Suraj Parkash, Sanjay Kumar, and Arun Kumar, expressed their dissatisfaction with the ongoing issues surrounding the power supply. They accused PDD of using wooden poles instead of cemented ones for



electric wires, with some wires dangerously positioned as low as 2 to 3 feet above the ground.

Despite repeated visits to the PDD office and meetings with Assistant Executive Engineers (AEE) and Assistant Engineers (AE), no action has been taken to address these concerns. The protesters raised safety concerns, fearing potential accidents involving humans and animals due to the substandard infrastructure.

The protesters also alleged that nearly 50% of PDD employees are unresponsive to the area's needs, while hundreds of local homes and businesses, including welding units and flour mills, continue to use electricity illegally without proper connections. The demand for a transformer, to address the region's low voltage issue, remains unmet.

In light of these issues, the community has appealed to the Lieutenant Governor to intervene and investigate the PDD's negligence in developing the border areas. They called for immediate action to ensure the safety and well-being of the residents.
