JAMMU: Dr. Rajeev Bhagat, MLA from Bishnah Assembly Constituency, held a Public Darbar at the Jammu & Kashmir BJP Headquarters in Trikuta Nagar; here on Tuesday, to engage directly with the public and address their grievances.
